- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 391.001(12), Transportation Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (12) "Specific information logo sign" means a
- 7 rectangular sign [panel] imprinted with the words "GAS," "FOOD,"
- 8 "LODGING," or "CAMPING," or with a combination of those words, and
- 9 the specific brand names of commercial establishments offering
- 10 those services.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 391.092(c), Transportation Code, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- (c) A specific information logo sign may not:
- (1) contain a message, symbol, or trademark that
- 15 resembles an official traffic-control device; or
- 16 (2) <u>be divided into [sentain]</u> more than six <u>panels</u>
- 17 <u>that contain</u> establishment names [for each sign panel].
- 18 SECTION 3. Section 391.093, Transportation Code, is amended
- 19 by amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (g) to read as
- 20 follows:
- 21 (c) An establishment that provides food must:
- (1) have any required license or other evidence
- 23 showing compliance with applicable public health or sanitation
- 24 laws;

1	(2) operate continuously at least $10 \ [12]$ hours a day
2	and serve <u>two</u> [three] meals a day; and
3	(3) provide:
4	(A) seating capacity for at least 16 persons;
5	(B) public restrooms; and
6	(C) a telephone for use by the public.
7	(g) An establishment is eligible to have two names displayed
8	on the same specific information logo sign panel if the
9	establishment provides:
10	(1) two food outlets in a shared space under common
11	ownership; or
12	(2) gas and food outlets in a shared space under common
13	ownership.
14	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
