- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 28, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 28.0212 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 28.0212. FINALITY OF GRADE. (a) An examination or
- 8 course grade issued by a classroom teacher is final and may not be
- 9 changed unless the grade is arbitrary, erroneous, or not consistent
- with the school district grading policy applicable to the grade, as
- 11 determined by the board of trustees of the school district in which
- 12 <u>the teacher is employed.</u>
- 13 (b) A determination by a school district board of trustees
- 14 under Subsection (a) is not subject to appeal. This subsection does
- 15 not prohibit an appeal related to a student's eligibility to
- 16 participate in extracurricular activities under Section 33.081.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2003-2004
- 18 school year.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
