- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 155.001(a), Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The commissioners court, on the request of a county
- 8 employee, may authorize a payroll deduction to be made from the
- 9 employee's wages or salary for:
- 10 (1) payment to a credit union;
- 11 (2) payment of membership dues in a labor union or a
- 12 bona fide employees association;
- 13 (3) payment of fees for parking in a county-owned
- 14 facility; [ex]
- 15 (4) payment to a charitable organization; or
- 16 (5) payment relating to an item not listed in this
- 17 <u>subsection if the commissioners court determines that the payment</u>
- 18 <u>serves a public purpose</u>.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
