<u>CHAPTER 300</u> H.B. No. 2846

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the authority of the State Office of Administrative
- 3 Hearings to conduct certain hearings over which the Railroad
- 4 Commission of Texas has jurisdiction.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. The following are repealed:
- 7 (1) Section 102.006, Utilities Code; and
- 8 (2) Section 2003.0491, Government Code.
- 9 SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 10 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 11 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 12 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- 13 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 14 (b) This Act applies to a hearing pending before the State
- 15 Office of Administrative Hearings on the effective date of this Act
- 16 under Section 102.006, Utilities Code, as that section existed
- 17 immediately before the effective date of this Act. A hearing
- 18 pending before the State Office of Administrative Hearings on the
- 19 effective date of this Act under Section 102.006, Utilities Code,
- 20 is transferred to the Railroad Commission of Texas on that date.
