- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 42, Human Resources Code,
- 7 is amended by adding Section 42.0443 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 42.0443. COORDINATION OF FIRE SAFETY AND SANITATION
- 9 INSPECTIONS. (a) The department may not inspect a licensed
- 10 day-care center, licensed group day-care home, or registered family
- 11 home for compliance with the department's fire safety or
- 12 sanitation standards if the facility, at the time of the
- 13 department's inspection, provides the department with
- 14 documentation relating to a current fire safety or sanitation
- inspection, as applicable, performed by a political subdivision of
- 16 this state that indicates that the facility is in compliance with
- 17 the applicable standards of the political subdivision.
- 18 (b) If the documentation provided under Subsection (a)
- 19 indicates that the facility was required to take corrective action
- 20 or that the political subdivision imposed a restriction or
- 21 condition on the facility, the department shall determine whether
- 22 the facility took the required corrective action or complied with
- 23 <u>the restriction or condition.</u>
- 24 (c) The department may inspect a facility subject to this

- 1 section for compliance with the department's fire safety or
- 2 sanitation standards if:
- 3 (1) the facility does not provide the documentation
- 4 described by Subsection (a); or
- 5 (2) the department determines that the facility did
- 6 not take a corrective action or comply with a restriction or
- 7 condition described by Subsection (b).
- 8 (d) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section,
- 9 the department shall report to the appropriate political
- 10 <u>subdivision any violation of fire safety or sanitation standards</u>
- observed by the department at a facility subject to this section.
- (e) The department shall adopt rules necessary to implement
- 13 this section.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
