9	kill, or injure in any way, an assistance animal.
.10	SECTION 2. Chapter, 42, Penal Code, is amended by adding
11	Section 42.091 to read as follows:
12	Sec. 42.091. ATTACK ON ASSISTANCE ANIMAL. (a) A person
13	commits an offense if the person intentionally, knowingly, or
14	recklessly attacks, injures, or kills an assistance animal.
15	(b) A person commits an offense if the person intentionally,
16	knowingly, or recklessly incites or permits an animal owned by or
17	otherwise in the custody of the actor to attack, injure, or kill an
18	assistance animal and, as a result of the person's conduct, the
19	assistance animal is attacked, injured, or killed.
20	(c) An offense under this section is a:
21	(1) Class A misdemeanor if the actor or an animal owned
22	by or otherwise in the custody of the actor attacks an assistance
23	animal;
24	(2) state jail felony if the actor or an animal owned

1	by or otherwise in the custody of the actor injures an assistance
2	animal; or
3	(3) felony of the third degree if the actor or an
4	animal owned by or otherwise in the custody of the actor kills an
5	assistance animal.
6	(d) A court shall order a defendant convicted of an offense
7	under Subsection (a) to make restitution to the owner of the
8	assistance animal for:
9	(1) related veterinary or medical bills;
10	(2) the cost of:
11	(A) replacing the assistance animal; or
12	(B) retraining an injured assistance animal by an
13	organization generally recognized by agencies involved in the
14	rehabilitation of persons with disabilities as reputable and
15	competent to provide special equipment for or special training to
16	an animal to help a person with a disability; and
17	(3) any other expense reasonably incurred as a result
18	of the offense.
19	(e) In this section:
20	(1) "Assistance animal" has the meaning assigned by
21	Section 121.002, Human Resources Code.
22	(2) "Custody" has the meaning assigned by Section
