2 precinct the candidate seeks to represent or that the candidate
3 seeks to represent the district at large.

4 (c) Notwithstanding Section 36.059, Water Code, a municipal
5 corporation in the district that is part of one precinct may be
6 included, in whole or in part, in another precinct.

7 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
8 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
9 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
10 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
11 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
