Table 1: Current Report. A. Type of Accident (Pedestrian, MTR Veh in Traffic, Railroad Train, etc.). B. Location (Interstate Routes, US & State Routes, etc.). C. Population Group (Under 2,500, 2,500 to 5,000, etc.). Columns include Total, Fatal, Injury, Non-Inj for On Roadway and Off Roadway.

Table 2: Number of Persons. Columns include Killed, Injured, Injury Severity (A, B, C). Rows correspond to accident types and locations.

Table 3: Comparative Totals. A. Type of Acc. (Pedestrian, MTR Veh in Traffic, etc.). B. Location (Interstate Routes, US & State Routes, etc.). C. Population Group (Under 2,500, 2,500 to 5,000, etc.). Columns include This Year to Date, Same Period Last Year, and % Change.

Table 4: Injury Severity. A. Incapacitating Injury - Severe Injury which prevents continuation of normal activities. B. Nonincapacitating Injury - Evident injury such as bruises, abrasions, minor lacerations which do not incapacitate. C. Possible Injury - Injury which is claimed, reported or indicated by behavior but without visible wounds. Includes limping, momentary unconsciousness or complaint of pain. Includes Mileage Rates, Reported Motor Vehicle Traffic Deaths, Reported Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries, Estimated Veh Miles Traveled (Millions), Death Rate per 100,000,000 Vehicle Miles, and Injury Rate per 100,000,000 Vehicle Miles.

Table 5: Time Hour Beginning. Columns include Total Acc's, Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Pedal/Pedcycl. Rows include time intervals from Midnight to 11:00 P.M.

NOTE: ALL FIGURES ON THIS REPORT ARE PRELIMINARY. To insure proper comparison, 1994 figures are the preliminary figures covering the same reporting period as those of 1995. Beginning with July 1, 1995 accidents, only property damage accidents having at least one vehicle towed due to damages will be tabulated; therefore, total accidents and non-injury accidents cannot be compared to prior year's totals.
