# DALLAS PUBLIC LIBRARY SEASON'S GREETINGS

The Members, Commissioner and staff of the State Securities Board all thank you for your cooperation during the past year and wish you a Merry Christmas and a prosperous New Year.

#### NOVEMBER PERMITS

The month of November, 1964, brought another gain over the preceding month in dollar value of securities registered for sale in Texas and also exceeded by a wider margin registrations for November, 1963.

Permits were issued in November, 1964, for 38 companies to sell \$44,644,517 in securities in Texas. The October total was \$41,585,781 to be sold by 48 companies. In November, 1963, registrations by 31 companies amounted to \$32,445,571.

Total dollar amount of securities processed for the first three months of this fiscal year was \$110,731,188 as compared to \$70,832,699 for the same period last year.

The total for November, 1964, consisted of \$33,032,352 in shares of mutual investment funds, \$3,276,580 of registrations by Texas companies and \$8,335,385 by foreign companies.

### ADMINISTRATIVE ORDERS

Lovera Oil and Gas, Inc. Box 2227 Abilene, Texas

Cease Publication Order issued November 5, 1964, when it appeared that non-producing working interests in oil and gas leases were to be offered for sale in Texas by Lovera Cil and Gas, Inc., without being registered.

Uni-Sol Uranium and Oil Corporation 2527 Carlisle Street Dallas, Texas

Cease and Desist Order issued November 9, 1964, after hearing held on November, 5, 1964. The Order stated in conclusion that further offer for sale of the securities issued by Uni-Sol Uranium and Oil Corporation would not be in compliance with the State Securities Act, would not be fair, just and equitable, and would tend to work a fraud on any purchaser thereof.

### ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

VERNON EVANS BERGMAN of Houston, Texas, was convicted November 19, 1964, for violation of the Texas Securities Act in the 27th Judicial District Court. Bergman was assessed a penalty of seven years confinement in the penitentiary by Judge James K. Evetts.

Bergman was indicted for selling the unregistered securities of Millican Mills, Inc., and for selling securities while not being a registered securities

District Attorney Stanley Kacir of Belton, Texas, advised that Bergman plead guilty in two separate cases to the offense of the sale of securities by a securities dealer not registered with the State Securities Board.

\* \* \*

On November 23, 1964, the Dallas County Grand Jury charged in two indictments that NEAL WOOD LYONS of Dallas, Texas, violated the State Securities Act.

The indictments charged that Lyons sold Uni-Sol Uranium and Oil Corporation stock in 1962 and 1963 although the stock was not registered with the State Securities Board and Lyons was not a licensed securities dealer.

#### LICENSE EXAMINATIONS

During November, a total of 66 examinations were administered to applicants for securities licenses. This included 33 examinations on general securities principles, 64 examinations on the Texas Securities Act and 1 Government Bond Examination. 63.66% of the applicants passed the general securities section on first attempt and 90.62% of the applicants passed the Texas Law Portion on first attempt. The applicant taking the bond examination failed for the second time.
