<u>CHAPTER 1025</u> H.B. No. 649

2	relating to creating an interagency work group on rural issues.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 487.054(a), Government Code, is amended
5	to read as follows:
6	(a) At least once each year, the following agency heads or
7	their designees shall meet in Austin to discuss rural issues and to
8	provide information showing the impact each agency has on rural
9	communities for use in developing rural policy and compiling the
10	annual report under Section 487.051(4):

12	(2) the executive director of the Public Utility
13	Commission of Texas;
14	(3) the director of the Texas Agricultural Extension
15	Service;
16	(4) the presiding officer of the Telecommunications

20	(6) the commissioner of health;
21	(7) the executive administrator of the Texas Water
22	Development Board;
23	(8) the executive director of the Parks and Wildlife

2	(10) the commissioner of higher education;
3	(11) the comptroller; [and]
4	(12) the executive director of the Texas Department of
5	Transportation:
6	(13) the presiding officer of the Texas Aerospace
7	Commission;
8	(14) the executive director of the Texas Commission on
9	Environmental Quality;
10	(15) the executive director of the Texas Department of

12	(16) the commissioner of insurance;
13	(17) the commissioner of mental health and mental

27	SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 487, Government Code, is

- amended by adding Section 487.0541 to read as follows:
- Sec. 487.0541. INTERAGENCY WORK GROUP. (a) An interagency
- 3 work group is created to:
- (1) develop a process to allow agencies to work
- 5 together on issues that face rural communities;
- 6 (2) discuss and coordinate programs and services
- 7 offered to rural communities and residents of rural communities;
- 8 <u>and</u>
- 9 (3) develop regulatory and legislative
- 10 recommendations that would eliminate duplication and combine
- 11 program services.
- 12 (b) The work group is composed of a representative from each
- 13 agency listed in or participating under Section 487.054(a)
- 14 appointed by the executive head of the agency.
- (c) The work group shall meet at the call of the executive
- 16 <u>director of the office</u>.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
