

1 AN ACT  
2 relating to parental notification of public school teacher  
3 qualifications.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 21.057, Education Code, is amended by  
6 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

7 (e) This section does not apply if a school is required in  
8 accordance with Section 1111(h)(6)(B)(ii), No Child Left Behind Act  
9 of 2001 (20 U.S.C. Section 6311), and its subsequent amendments, to  
10 provide notice to a parent or guardian regarding a teacher who is  
11 not highly qualified, provided the school provides notice as  
12 required by that Act.

13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
17 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
