5	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 661, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Sections 661.916 and 661.917 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 661.916. LEAVE FOR ORGAN OR BONE MARROW DONORS. (a) A
8	state employee is entitled to a leave of absence without a deduction
9	in salary for the time necessary to permit the employee to serve as
10	a bone marrow or organ donor.
11	(b) The leave of absence provided by this section may not
12	exceed:
13	(1) five working days in a fiscal year to serve as a
14	bone marrow donor; or
15	(2) 30 working days in a fiscal year to serve as an
16	organ donor.
17	Sec. 661.917. DONATION OF BLOOD. (a) A state agency shall
18	allow each agency employee sufficient time off, without a deduction
19	in salary or accrued leave, to donate blood.
20	(b) An employee may not receive time off under this section
21	unless the employee obtains approval from the employee's supervisor
22	before taking time off.
23	(c) On returning to work after taking time off under this
24	section, an employee shall provide the employee's supervisor with

- 1 proof that the employee donated blood during the time off. If an
- employee fails to provide proof that the employee donated blood
- 3 during the time off, the state agency shall deduct the period for
- 4 which the employee was granted time off from the employee's salary
- 5 or accrued leave, whichever the employee chooses.
- 6 (d) An employee may receive time off under this section not
- 7 more than four times in a fiscal year.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
