OCTOBER PERMITS

The State Securities Board issued permits in October for 119 issuers to sell \$140,279,981 in securities -- a \$39 Million gain over September of this year and a \$15 Million gain over October, 1971.

Total dollar amount of securities applications processed for the first two months of the fiscal year is \$251,389,401. Total number of units processed for the first two months of the fiscal year is 211.

LICENSE INFORMATION

During October a total of 143 examinations were administered to 129 applicants for licensing under the Texas Securities Act. This included 15 examinations on general securities principles, and 123 examinations on the Texas Securities Act. There were 80.0% of the applicants who passed the general securities section on first attempt and 91.9% who passed the Texas Law portion on first attempt.

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On October 11, 1972, the Securities Commissioner issued an order revoking the secondary trading exemption that may be claimed under Section 5.0 of The Securities Act with respect to securities issued by Fluidic Industries, Inc., a Delaware corporation. The Commissioner found that from information available, there was reasonable cause to believe that the sale of such securities would not meet the secondary trading exemption requirements of Section 5.0 of The Texas Securities Act in that: Fluidic Industries, Inc. on October 2, 1972, filed for reorganization under Chapter XI of the Federal Bankruptcy Act.

ORDER NO. CD-489 October 4, 1972

On October 4, 1972, the Deputy Securities Commissioner ordered that the sale of securities of Regional Airport Investment, Inc.; Regional Airport Investment d/b/a, and Lynn Bural and Associates cease and desist, and

that the sale of such securities be prohibited. The order was based on conclusions of the Deputy Commissioner that the sale of the securities of the subject companies would tend to work a fraud upon, and would not be fair, just and equitable to any purchaser thereof, and would not be in compliance with The Securities Act.

CONVICTIONS

Robert C. Beck, former President of Primal Energy Corporation, who resides at 9038 Klondike, Houston, Texas, was found guilty of the offense of unlawful sale of unregistered securities in the 182nd District Court of Harris County, Texas, on October 16, 1972, after entering a plea of guilty before the Court. Beck was assessed a penalty of one year in the penitentiary. The sentence was probated upon condition that Beck make restitution in the amount of \$6,250.00.

Albert Lee Woolard of Fort Worth, Texas, was convicted of the offense of the unlawful sale of the unregistered securities of American Airmen's Investment Corporation after entering a plea of guilty in the Criminal District Court of Tarrant County, Texas, on October 25, 1972. Woolard was assessed a fine of \$1,000.00 by District Judge Gordon Gray.

INDICTMENTS

Dallas County District Attorney Henry Wade informed the Securities Commissioner that a Dallas County Grand Jury on October 10, 1972, had returned indictments against William Doyle and Douglas R. Loder for violations of The Securities Act in the sale of oil and gas interests located in Runnels County, Texas. Doyle was indicted in a three-count indictment for the sale of an oil and gas interest on October 11, 1969. The indictment alleges that Doyle sold unregistered securities, acted as an unregistered dealer, and committed fraud in the sale of the securities. The indictment against Loder is based on the same sale and contains the same allegations.
