NOVEMBER PERMITS

In November the State Securities Board issued permits for 92 issuers to sell \$110,329,081 in securities.

Total dollar amount of securities applications processed for the first three months of the fiscal year was \$330,563,765 as compared to \$384,396,664 for the same period last year. Total number of applications processed for the first three months of the fiscal year was 255.

LICENSE INFORMATION

During November a total of 150 examinations were administered to 143 applicants for licensing under the Texas Securities Act. This included 138 examinations on the Texas Securities Act, 7 examinations on the General Securities Principles and 5 examinations on the Special Bond Examination. There were 89.9% of the applicants who passed the Texas Law portion, 100% of the applicants who passed the General Securities portion, and 20% of the applicants who passed the Special Bond Examination.

CONVICTIONS

Donald Gary Norton was sentenced to eight years in the penitentiary for fraud in the sale of securities on November 1, 1973, in Harris County, by District Judge Lee Duggan.

Norton was indicted on November 11, 1971, by a Harris County Grand Jury for fraud in the sale of securities and felony embezzlement in connection with his solicitation of orders for \$55,622.04 in corporate bonds from a Houston widow. He pleaded nolo contendere and was found guilty of the fraud charge on February 6, 1973.

Dave Wilson and Sammy Lewis, municipal bond salesman from Southaven, Mississippi, formerly associated with Milam Investments, Inc., were convicted of the sale of securities while unlicensed in this State and fined \$3,000.00 each. The case involved the sale of East St. Louis Illinois Bridge Revenue Refunding and Improvement Bonds due 1-1-85 to a Houston man. Wallace P. Milam, owner and manager of Milam Investments, Inc. is under indictment on similar charges in Falls County, Texas, for the sale of bonds of the same issuer.

Oran James Barron, III of Spur, Texas, entered a plea of guilty to the sale of securities as an unregistered dealer in Waco on November 9, 1973. The charges grew out of the sale of unregistered securities of SUR International, Inc., to McLennan County residents. Barron was president of SUR International, Inc., a Dallas based corporation. He was sentenced to two years in the penitentiary, but imposition of the sentence was postponed pending investigation of Barron's application for probation. On November 29, 1973, Bill Harper of Investors Associates of America, Inc., pleaded guilty to the charge of the sale of securities as an unregistered dealer in Austin, Texas. Investors Associates of America, Inc. was a Memphis based municipal bond dealership and Harper testified at the trial that he had made sales throughout the State of Texas, one of which was in Austin. Harper received a \$500.00 fine.

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INDICTMENTS

A Harris County Grand Jury returned a three-count indictment against Kenneth W. Schmidt alleging that he sold unregistered securities, acted as an unregistered securities dealer and fraudulently sold securities of a real estate syndication limited partnership, which he was to organize. Securities involved were for a limited partnership which was called "150 LIMITED".

A Dallas County Grand Jury returned a three-count indictment for violations of The Securities Act in the sale of shares of Von Heisler International Enterprises, Inc., by Michael Von Heisler who was Chairman of the Board of the company. The indictment alleged fraud by Von Heisler in representing that an investment of 100 shares at a purchase price of \$20,000.00 in the capital stock of Von Heisler International Enterprises, Inc. would be worth \$500,000.00 when Von Heisler International Enterprises, Inc. went public by the end of 1972.

ORDER REVOKING REGISTRATION AS A SECURITIES SALESMAN

Troy Lynn Harrison's license as a securities salesman with Hamilton Management Corporation was revoked on November 13, 1973, after a hearing before the Deputy Securities Commissioner. Deputy Commissioner A. J. Ellisor found that Harrison had made material misrepresentations to the Commissioner in connection with information deemed necessary by the Commissioner to determine his business repute and qualifications as a securities salesman. This stemmed out of a statement by Harrison that he had not sold or offered for sale securities in Lake Havasu Estates, an Arizona corporation, when, in fact, he had. Deputy Commissioner Ellisor also found that Harrison had refused to give certain information to the Commissioner and that Harrison had violated Section 7 of The Securities Act by selling unregistered securities of Lake Havasu Estates.

CEASE PUBLICATION NOTICE

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Securities Commissioner Roy Mouer ordered that an advertisement entitled "Investment Opportunity", soliciting 300-400 thousand dollars partly as equity investment and partly as shareholder loans, to be in violation of Section 22 of the Texas Securities Act and he also found that Sefel & Associates was not a registered securities dealer or investment adviser in the State of Texas, nor had any securities issued by Sefel & Associates ever been registered for sale in the State of Texas. The Commissioner also found that the advertisement failed to disclose material facts necessary in order to make the representations made not misleading to purchasers. ORDER NO. LD-512

ORDER DENYING APPLICATION TO BE REGISTERED AS A SECURITIES SALESMAN

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Securities Commissioner Roy Mouer found that Billy Neil Pollan had been convicted of the felony offenses of burglary and cattle theft and also had made material misrepresentations to the Commissioner in connection with information deemed necessary to determine his business repute and qualifications. These misrepresentations involved a statement on Pollan's application that from September, 1963, to August, 1966, he worked for the Wittredge Towing Company, Highlands, Texas, when, in fact, for a portion of that time he was confined in the Texas Department of Corrections in Huntsville, Texas. Pollan had made application to be licensed with Securities Management & Research, Inc.

INJUNCTIONS

On November 8, 1973, a temporary Restraining Order was entered against Stocks International Commodities, Inc., Guaranteed Commodities, Inc., International Commodities, Inc., and Michael T. Stocks to prohibit them from the sale and offering for sale of commodity options. A temporary receiver was also appointed. The Judge in this case was Spencer Carver, 191st District Court in Dallas County, Texas.

On November 15, 1973, an order was entered granting a temporary injunction and temporary receiver against Commodity Marketing Group, Inc., Standard Trading Corporation and Commercial Trading Corporation. The injunction prohibited the above from selling and offering for sale commodity options in the State of Texas without first obtaining the registration thereof. Commercial Trading Corporation had earlier won a declaratory judgment action in Austin, Texas, which held that the commodity options sold by them were not securities; however, they consented to the injunction in 162nd Judicial District Court in Dallas County, Texas, where Judge Dee Brown Walker signed the order.
