RECORD-BREAKING FISCAL YEAR

Securities registered for public sale in Texas during the last fiscal year soared close to the Two Billion Dollar mark for the first time in the twenty-year history of the State Securities Board.

Issues of stocks, bonds and other securities regulated by the Texas Securities Act and processed by the Board's staff during the fiscal year ending August 31, 1977, totaled \$2,029,027,689. This exceeds the previous record-breaking volume set in 1972 by over \$312 Million. Permits granted by the Board in fiscal 1977 totaled \$1,988,299,960. The difference between securities processed and permits granted represents issues either withdrawn, abandoned or denied.

The dollar amount of securities registered for sale in Texas in fiscal 1976 was slightly more than \$1.5 Billion. The State Securities Board report for the month of August, 1977, reflects that permits were granted for the sale of securities of 109 issues totaling \$227,918,204, which far exceeds the \$136 Million value of permits granted for the entire twelve months of fiscal 1958, the first year of the Board's operation.

LICENSE INFORMATION

During August, a total of 215 examinations were administered to 214 applicants for licensing under the Texas Securities Act. This included 205 examinations on the Texas Securities Act, 3 examinations on the General Securities Principles and 7 examinations on the Special Bond Examination. There were 56.6% of the applicants who passed the Texas Law Portion, 33.4% of the applicants who passed the General Securities Portion, and 85.7% of the applicants who passed the Special Bond Examination.

ORDER VACATING CEASE AND DESIST ORDER CD-319 PROHIBITING THE SALE OF SECURITIES OF POWER OIL COMPANY AND VACATING ORDER NO. 5.0-309 REVOKING SECONDARY TRADING EXEMPTION OF THE TEXAS SECURITIES ACT WITH RESPECT TO SECURITIES ISSUED BY POWER OIL COMPANY

Deputy Securities Commissioner Frank Arnold found on August 3, 1977, that the circumstances surrounding the issuance and sale of Power Oil Company securities that provoked the issuance of Order CD-319 and Order 5.0-309 appeared to have been corrected; consequently, both Orders were vacated. The ruling, however, made no determination of the availability or non-availability of Section 5.0 of The Securities Act for the secondary trading in securities of the company.

CONVICTIONS

A Dallas County Jury in the 4th Criminal District Court convicted Max Walton Nunn of Dallas, Texas, of the sale of unregistered securities of Numar Corporation. As a result of this conviction and the introduction of evidence in the punishment phase of the trial showing previous felony convictions of Nunn, the jury found him to be an habitual offender. Under provisions of the Texas Habitual Felony Offender Statute, Nunn faces a mandatory life sentence in the Texas Department of Corrections. Formal sentencing was set for September 2, 1977.

After entering a plea of nolo contendere, (in the 209th District Court of Harris County) Samuel J. Wiesenthal, an attorney and former Municipal Court Judge in Houston, Texas, was found guilty of engaging in the sale of unregistered securities. The securities in question were "put", "call" and "double options" on commodity futures contracts issued by King Commodity Company of Texas, Inc., a now defunct brokerage house. Wiesenthal was assessed a one (1) year probated sentence.
