#### SEPTEMBER PERMITS

In September the State Securities Board issued permits for 92 issuers to sell \$117,207,038 in securities -- an increase of \$32 Million over the preceding month and a \$73 Million gain over the same month last

Total dollar amount of securities applications processed for the first month of the new fiscal year was \$126,093,607 as compared to \$51,731,453 for the same period last year. Total number of applications processed for the first month of the fiscal year was 109.

#### LICENSE INFORMATION

During September a total of 140 examinations were administered to 133 applicants for licensing under the Texas Securities Act. This included ll6 examinations on the Texas Securities Act, 12 examinations on the General Securities Principles and 12 examinations on the Special Bond Examination. There were 91.3% of the applicants who passed the Texas Law portion, 75% of the applicants who passed the General Securities portion, and 91.7% of the applicants who passed the Special Bond examination.

ORDER NO. 5.0-524

ORDER REVOKING SECONDARY TRADING EXEMPTION OF THE TEXAS SECURITIES ACT WITH RESPECT TO SECURITIES ISSUED BY OMEGA-ALPHA, INC.

Securities Commissioner Roy W. Mouer found that on September 30, 1974, he had reasonable cause to believe that the sale of securities of Omega-Alpha, Inc., a Delaware Corporation, did not meet the secondary trading exemption requirements of Section 5.0 under The Securities Act in that Omega-Alpha, Inc., had filed under Chapter XI of the Federal Bankruptcy Act on September 27, 1974.

#### INDICTMENTS

The Harris County Grand Jury has returned two indictments against William C. Minton of Houston, Texas, and William D. Schreiner of Patton Village, Texas, charging them with the sale of unregistered securities, the sale of securities by an unregistered dealer or salesman and fraud in the sale of securities.

One indictment against Minton and Schreiner charges them with the sale of \$2,000 worth of stock in Flowers Forever, Inc., to a Humble, Texas, resident. The second indictment against Minton and Schreiner involves the sale of another \$2,000 in Flowers Forever, Inc., to a Houston resident.
