

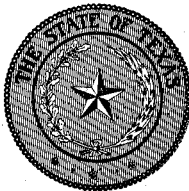

THE LOCAL REGISTRAR

(Vital Statistics Law, 1927, as amended, 1929)

The Justice of the Peace in the precinct and the City Clerk or Secretary in the city of 2,500 or more is the Local Registrar of births and deaths. These officials shall secure a complete record of each birth and death that occurs within their jurisdiction. (Sec. 3.)

Each Local Registrar is charged with the strict and thorough enforcement of this law in his registration district. He shall report to the State Registrar any violation of this law coming to his knowledge. (Sec. 23.)

He shall select a Deputy-Registrar so that a Registrar may be available at all times for registration, but all reports shall be signed by the Registrar. (Sec. 4.)

He shall supply blanks to such persons as require them.

He shall carefully examine each certificate when presented for record. If a certificate of death is incomplete or unsatisfactory, he shall call attention to the defects, and withhold the permit until such defects are corrected. When the certificate of death is completed, he shall issue the permit. If a certificate of birth is incomplete, the Registrar shall notify the informant, and require him to supply the necessary information. (Sec. 19.)

He shall sign the certificate as Registrar, with the date of filing in his office. He forwards on or before the 10th day of each month, to the State Bureau, the original certificates registered by him during the preceding month. (Sec. 19.)

The Registrar in the Precinct shall file with the Commissioners' Court or the County Auditor a true and accurate copy of each certificate filed with him. (Sec. 20.)

BIRTH REGISTRATION

(Vital Statistics Law, 1927, as amended, 1929)

The birth of each and every child born in this State shall be registered. (Sec. 12.) Within five days after birth, there shall be filed with the Registrar of the district in which the birth occurred, a certificate of such birth. A physician, midwife, or person acting as a midwife in attendance upon the birth shall file the certificate of birth. Where no physician or midwife is present at the birth, it shall be the duty of the father or mother to report to the Registrar the fact of such birth. (Sec. 13.)

DEATH REGISTRATION

The body of any person whose death occurs in this State shall not be interred or otherwise disposed of, or removed from or into any registration district unless a permit for burial, removal or other disposition thereof shall have been properly issued by the local registrar. (Sec. 5.)

Any person who wishes to bury a dead body shall file the certificate of death with, and obtain a permit from the registrar of the district in which the death occurred. (Sec. 9.)

PENALTIES

Any person who:

- (a) Shall inter or otherwise dispose of the dead body of a human being, or shall remove a body from the registration district in which the death occurred or the body was found, without the authority of a permit issued by the registrar of the district in which the death occurred or in which the body was found; or
- (b) Shall refuse or fail to furnish correctly any information in his possession; or (c) shall furnish false information affecting any certificate or record required by this Act; or (d) shall wilfully alter; or (e) shall falsify any certificate of birth or death; or
- (f) Being required by this Act to fill out a certificate and file the same with the registrar, shall fail, or refuse to perform such duty in the manner required by this Act; or
- (g) Being a Local Registrar shall fail or refuse to perform his duty as required by this Act;

Shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall for the first offense be fined not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$50.00, and for each subsequent offense not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00 or be imprisoned in the county jail not more than sixty days, or be both fined and imprisoned.

REGULATIONS FOR FILING UNREGISTERED BIRTHS AND DEATHS

(1) The affidavit of the medical attendant in the case of a birth, and the affidavit of the person who buried the body in the case of a death, shall be attached to the certificate if the birth or death occurred since 1909, but was not filed within the time limit prescribed by law.

(2) To the certificate of a birth or death which occurred prior to 1909, and in those cases since 1909 where the affidavit of the physician or the person who buried the body cannot be secured, two affidavits shall be attached.

The certificate shall be signed by, and the first affidavit executed by some responsible person acquainted with the facts at the time of the event. The second affidavit shall be executed by someone not related to the individual by blood or marriage.

(3) Birth and death certificates to which the necessary affidavits have been attached shall be submitted to the local registrar in the precinct or in the city where the birth or death occurred, and when the local registrar has been satisfied that the certificate is a bona fide record, he shall place his file date and signature on the record and shall forward that record to the State Bureau of Vital Statistics immediately.

(4) Any resident of Texas may file with the State Bureau of Vital Statistics the record of a birth or death which occurred outside of the State of Texas, when such record is authenticated as provided for in regulations 1 and 2.

(5) Any resident of Texas may file with the State Bureau of Vital Statistics the certified or photostatic copy of the record of any birth or death, when such copy is supported by an affidavit stating that the entries made on the original record were made on or about the time the events occurred.

(6) All records of birth and deaths shall be filed on the forms adopted and furnished by the State Board of Health.
