

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, House Bill No. 2343 has been adopted by the house of
2 representatives and the senate and is being prepared for
3 enrollment; and

4 WHEREAS, The bill contains technical errors that should be
5 corrected; now, therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED by the 78th Legislature of the State of Texas, That
7 the enrolling clerk of the house of representatives be instructed
8 to make the following corrections:

9 (1) In SECTION 1(b) of the bill, strike "If Walker County
10 uses the property for any purpose other than a purpose that benefits
11 the public interest of the state," and substitute "If Walker County
12 uses the property for any purpose other than the construction and
13 operation of a museum that memorializes veterans,".

14 (2) In SECTION 1(c)(1)(A) of the bill, strike "Walker County
15 may use the property only for a purpose that benefits the public
16 interest of the state" and substitute "Walker County shall use the
17 property only for the construction and operation of a museum that
18 memorializes veterans".
