2 2002, at the age of 51, brought a great loss to the family and

6 public servant who began his career in 1975 with the Texas  
7 Department of Human Services; he was a staunch believer in

11 serving the residents of Uvalde County and dedicated himself to  
12 ensuring the availability of education, food, housing, and health  
13 care for all; and

14           WHEREAS, Mr. Nevarez played a vital role in securing funding  
15 for Uvalde's Community Health Center; he later served as the  
16 consumer board member representative on the National Association of  
17 Community Health Centers' Board of Directors; and

18           WHEREAS, A devoted family man, Mr. Nevarez was a loving  
19 husband, father, son, brother, and grandfather; the needs of his  
20 family always came first and he took great pride in supporting their  
21 endeavors and in celebrating their accomplishments; and

22           WHEREAS, The citizens of Uvalde County and the family and  
23 friends of Mr. Nevarez were truly blessed to have him as their ally  
24 and *amigo de verdad*, and although his passing has left a void in

1 their lives, his legacy and spirit will live on for years to come;  
2 now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That the 78th Legislature of the State of Texas  
4 hereby pay tribute to the life of Jose Ricardo Nevarez and extend  
5 sincere sympathy to the members of his family; and, be it further

6 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be  
7 prepared for his family and that when the house of representatives  
8 and senate adjourn this day, they do so in memory of Jose Ricardo  
9 Nevarez.
