2 relating to the application of the open meetings law to certain
3 health maintenance organizations.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 551.085, Government Code, is amended to
6 read as follows:

7 Sec. 551.085. GOVERNING BOARD OF CERTAIN PROVIDERS OF
8 HEALTH CARE SERVICES. (a) This chapter does not require the
9 governing board of a municipal hospital, municipal hospital
10 authority, hospital district created under general or special law,
11 or nonprofit health maintenance organization created under Section
12 534.101, Health and Safety Code, to conduct an open meeting to
13 deliberate:

14 (1) pricing or financial planning information
15 relating to a bid or negotiation for the arrangement or provision of
16 services or product lines to another person if disclosure of the
17 information would give advantage to competitors of the hospital,
18 hospital district, or nonprofit health maintenance organization;
19 or

20 (2) information relating to a proposed new service or
21 product line of the hospital, hospital district, or nonprofit
22 health maintenance organization before publicly announcing the
23 service or product line.

24 (b) The governing board of a health maintenance

1 organization created under Section 281.0515, Health and Safety
2 Code, that is subject to this chapter is not required to conduct an
3 open meeting to deliberate information described by Subsection (a).

4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
