12	this state unless the adoption law or process of the foreign country
13	violates the fundamental principles of human rights or the laws or
14	public policy of this state.
15	(b) A person who adopts a child in a foreign country may
16	register the order in this state. A petition for registration of a
17	foreign adoption order may be combined with a petition for a name
18	change. If the court finds that the foreign adoption order meets
19	the requirements of Subsection (a), the court shall order the state
20	registrar to:
21	(1) register the order under Chapter 192, Health and
22	Safety Code; and
23	(2) file a certificate of birth for the child under

Section 192.006, Health and Safety Code.
