7	(a) The Comal County Juvenile Board is composed of:
8	(1) the county judge;
9	(2) [7] the <u>local administrative statutory county</u>
10	judge <u>;</u>
11	(3) [of the County Court at Law of Comal County, and]
12	the judge of the 207th District Court;
13	(4) an additional judge of the district courts having
14	jurisdiction in Comal County, to be appointed biennially by the
15	local administrative district judge; and
16	(5) the criminal district attorney of Comal County.
17	(a-1) The criminal district attorney of Comal County may not
18	vote except to break a tie vote of the other members of the board.
19	SECTION 2. Not later than October 1, 2003, the presiding
20	judge of the district courts having jurisdiction in Comal County
21	shall appoint a district court judge to the Comal County Juvenile
22	Board as required by Subsection (a), Section 152.0521, Human
23	Resources Code, as amended by this Act.
24	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
