<u>CHAPTER 124</u> <u>S.B. No. 7</u>

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the recognition of a same-sex marriage or a civil union.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 6, Family Code, is amended
5	by adding Section 6.204 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 6.204. RECOGNITION OF SAME-SEX MARRIAGE OR CIVIL
7	UNION. (a) In this section, "civil union" means any relationship
8	status other than marriage that:
9	(1) is intended as an alternative to marriage or
10	applies primarily to cohabitating persons; and
11	(2) grants to the parties of the relationship legal
12	protections, benefits, or responsibilities granted to the spouses
13	of a marriage.
14	(b) A marriage between persons of the same sex or a civil
15	union is contrary to the public policy of this state and is void in
16	this state.
17	(c) The state or an agency or political subdivision of the
18	state may not give effect to a:
19	(1) public act, record, or judicial proceeding that
20	creates, recognizes, or validates a marriage between persons of the
21	same sex or a civil union in this state or in any other
22	jurisdiction; or
23	(2) right or claim to any legal protection, benefit,
24	or responsibility asserted as a result of a marriage between

- 1 persons of the same sex or a civil union in this state or in any
- 2 <u>other jurisdiction</u>.
- 3 SECTION 2. The legislature finds that through the
- 4 designation of guardians, the appointment of agents, and the use of
- 5 private contracts persons may adequately and properly appoint
- 6 guardians and arrange rights relating to hospital visitation,
- 7 property, and the entitlement to proceeds of life insurance
- 8 policies without the existence of any legally recognized familial
- 9 relationship between the persons.
- SECTION 3. This Act applies to a same-sex marriage or a
- 11 civil union regardless of whether the marriage or civil union was
- 12 entered into before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
