
<u>CHAPTER 1185</u>
<u>S.B. No. 734</u>

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the power of appointment in certain municipalities

- 3 having city managers.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 25.051, Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- ·7 Sec. 25.051. OTHER MUNICIPAL OFFICERS. (a) After a
- 8 municipality adopts the city manager form of government under this
- 9 chapter, all municipal officers, except members of the governing
- 10 body of the municipality, shall be appointed as provided by
- 11 ordinance. However, an elected officer serving at the time of the
- 12 adoption of the city manager form of government may continue to
- 13 serve until the expiration of the officer's term.
- 14 (b) This chapter does not limit the authority of the
- 15 governing body of a general-law municipality to appoint and
- 16 prescribe the powers and duties of a municipal officer or employee
- 17 under Chapter 22, 23, or 24.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
