6	Sec. 659.024. COMPENSATORY TIME FOR PERSONS GOVERNING STATE
7	AGENCIES. (a) In this section, "state agency" has the meaning
8	assigned by Section 658.001.
9	(b) This section does not apply to an employee who acts as
10	the administrative head of a state agency, including an executive
11	director.
12	(c) A member of the governing body of a state agency or a
13	single state officer who governs a state agency may not accrue
14	compensatory time under this subchapter or another state statute.
15	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
