

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The Legislature of the State of Texas is pleased to  
3 recognize Herb Miller for winning five medals at the state  
4 competition of the Senior Olympics held in Lubbock from August 26 to  
5 September 1, 2002; and

6 WHEREAS, Herb Miller also participated in the regional senior  
7 games from March 10 to March 16, 2002, in Temple, Texas, setting a  
8 golf scoring record of 68 and 70 for a total of 138, and he had the  
9 first double eagle in Senior Olympics Games history; and

10 WHEREAS, The Senior Olympics Texas State Games are sanctioned  
11 by the National Senior Games Association for athletes who are at  
12 least 50 years old; participants compete in 18 different sporting  
13 events, including golf, discus, basketball, and track and field;  
14 and

15 WHEREAS, Herb Miller won a gold medal in basketball, a silver  
16 medal in golf, a silver medal in the discus, a bronze medal in the  
17 high jump, and a bronze medal in the shot put, and he qualified for  
18 the national competition scheduled in Hampton Roads, Virginia, from  
19 May 26 to June 9, 2003; and

20 WHEREAS, Herb enjoyed athletic competition in discus and shot  
21 put and in swimming and football in high school and college; he is a  
22 graduate of Louisiana Tech University, where he was All-State in  
23 basketball, football, and track; and

24 WHEREAS, This exemplary athlete has participated in the

1 Senior Olympics for the past six years, sometimes competing against  
2 former high school and college rivals; he takes pleasure in  
3 watching athletes in their 80s and 90s take part in the games; and

4 WHEREAS, Herb Miller has demonstrated exceptional athletic  
5 ability and has confirmed the value and pleasure of lifelong  
6 athletic participation; he has brought great honor to himself, to  
7 his community, and to the State of Texas; now, therefore, be it

8 RESOLVED, That the 78th Legislature of the State of Texas  
9 hereby commend Herb Miller on his outstanding achievements and  
10 extend to him best wishes for success in the national Senior  
11 Olympics; and, be it further

12 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be prepared for him  
13 as an expression of esteem from the Texas Legislature.
