## 1 <u>SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION</u>

- 2 proposing a constitutional amendment relating to the provision of
- 3 parks and recreational facilities by certain conservation and
- 4 reclamation districts.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is
- 7 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c-1) to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 (a) The conservation and development of all of the natural
- 10 resources of this State, and development of parks and recreational
- 11 facilities, including the control, storing, preservation and
- 12 distribution of its storm and flood waters, the waters of its rivers
- and streams, for irrigation, power and all other useful purposes,
- 14 the reclamation and irrigation of its arid, semi-arid and other
- 15 lands needing irrigation, the reclamation and drainage of its
- 16 overflowed lands, and other lands needing drainage, the
- 17 conservation and development of its forests, water and
- 18 hydro-electric power, the navigation of its inland and coastal
- 19 waters, and the preservation and conservation of all such natural
- 20 resources of the State are each and all hereby declared public
- 21 rights and duties; and the Legislature shall pass all such laws as
- 22 may be appropriate thereto.
- 23 (c-1) In addition and only as provided by this subsection,
- 24 the Legislature may authorize conservation and reclamation
- 25 districts to develop and finance with taxes those types and

categories of parks and recreational facilities that were not 1 authorized by this section to be developed and financed with taxes 2 before September 13, 2003. For development of such parks and 3 facilities, the Legislature may authorize 4 recreational indebtedness payable from taxes as may be necessary to provide for 5 improvements and maintenance only for a conservation and 6 reclamation district all or part of which is located in Bexar 7 County, Bastrop County, Waller County, Travis County, Williamson 8 County, Harris County, Galveston County, Brazoria County, Fort Bend 9 County, or Montgomery County, or for the Tarrant Regional Water 10 District, a water control and improvement district located in whole 11 or in part in Tarrant County. All the indebtedness may be evidenced 12 by bonds of the conservation and reclamation district, to be issued 13 under regulations as may be prescribed by law. The Legislature may 14 also authorize the levy and collection within such district of all 15 taxes, equitably distributed, as may be necessary for the payment 16 of the interest and the creation of a sinking fund for the payment 17 of the bonds and for maintenance of and improvements to such parks 18 and recreational facilities. The indebtedness shall be a lien on 19 the property assessed for the payment of the bonds. The Legislature 20 may not authorize the issuance of bonds or provide for indebtedness 21 under this subsection against a conservation and reclamation 22 district unless a proposition is first submitted to the qualified 23 voters of the district and the proposition is adopted. 24 subsection expands the authority of the Legislature with respect to 25 certain conservation and reclamation districts and is not a 26 limitation on the authority of the Legislature with respect to 27

- 1 conservation and reclamation <u>districts</u> and <u>parks</u> and <u>recreational</u>
- 2 facilities pursuant to this section as that authority existed
- 3 before September 13, 2003.
- 4 SECTION 2. The legislature intends by the amendment
- 5 proposed by Section 1 of this resolution to expand the authority of
- 6 the legislature with regard to certain conservation and reclamation
- 7 districts. The proposed amendment should not be construed as a
- 8 limitation on the powers of the legislature or of a district with
- 9 respect to parks and recreational facilities as those powers exist
- 10 immediately before the amendment takes effect.
- 11 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 12 submitted to the voters at an election to be held September 13,
- 13 2003. The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against
- 14 the proposition: "The constitutional amendment relating to the
- 15 provision of parks and recreational facilities by certain
- 16 conservation and reclamation districts."
