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U.S.-Mexico Trade: Final 2003 Total Trade Figures Were Up, But Trade Deficit Grew

2003 total trade (U.S. exports to Mexico plus U.S. imports from Mexico) finished the year with an increase of 1.4 percent, but the U.S. trade deficit with Mexico grew by 9.2 percent.

Tables 1-4 provide a detail account of the trade activity between the trading partners and a comparison with 2002 figures. Border ports of entry handled 82.6 percent of this trade in 2003. —B. Garcia

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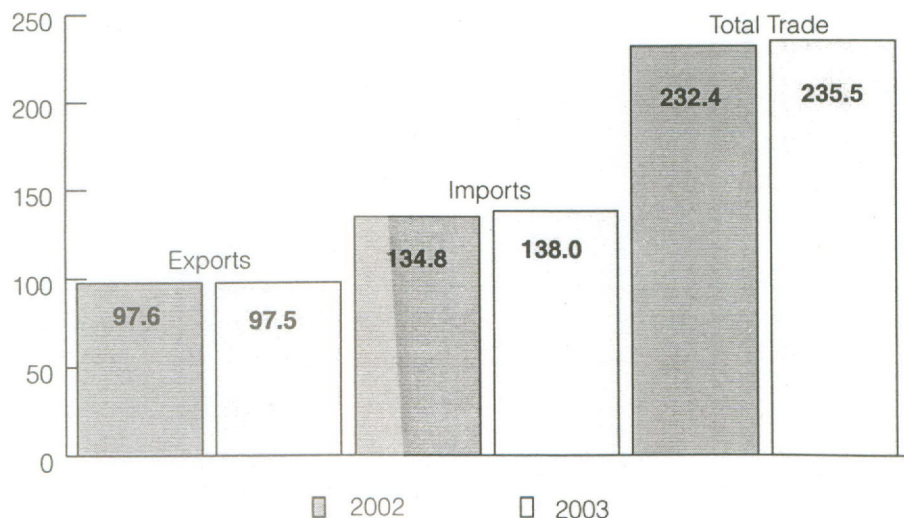
Note from the Director

Indicators of border business activity for December 2003 end-of-year (EOY) demonstrated ten indicators increased and twelve decreased. 2003 EOY comparisons to 2002 reported for the border are listed below:

- Pedestrian bridge crossings into Mexico were down 6.4 percent.
- Pedestrian bridge crossings into Texas were down 5.7 percent.
- Vehicle bridge crossings into Mexico fell 5.7 percent.
- Vehicle bridge crossings into Texas fell 6.3 percent.
- Truck bridge crossings into Mexico lost 3.9 percent.
- Truck bridge crossings into Texas lost 4.7 percent.
- Rail car bridge crossings into Mexico went up 2.4 percent.
- Rail car bridge crossings into Texas went down 6.7 percent.
- Revenues collected by U.S. Customs decreased 2.9 percent.
- Revenues collected by U.S. bridge operators registered a gain of 0.8 percent.
- Tourist Visas issued for entry into Mexico were up 2.1 percent.
- Total employment was up 4.0 percent, with 19,013 jobs gained. The average unemployment rate for the border in December 2003 was 8.9 percent.
- Total building permits issued rose 2.7 percent.
- Total building permit values decreased 3.2 percent.
- Power Connections in service for residential were up 2.6 percent, commercial were up 3.3 percent and industrial were up 1.4 percent.
- Air passenger arrivals were down 2.0 percent, and departures were down 2.2 percent.
- Total cargo for the Port of Brownsville decreased 20.6 percent.
- Inbound cargo for the Port of Corpus Chrisit went up 5.4 percent, and outbound cargo went up 4.8 percent.

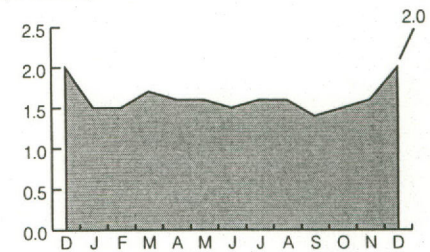

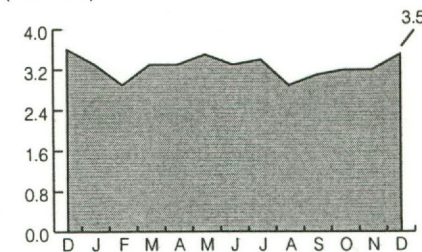

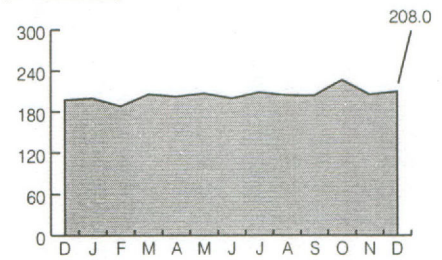

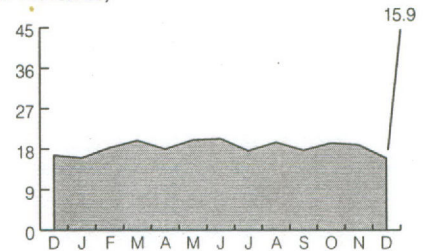

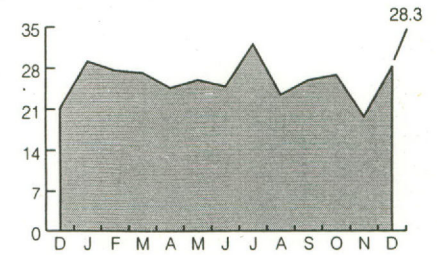

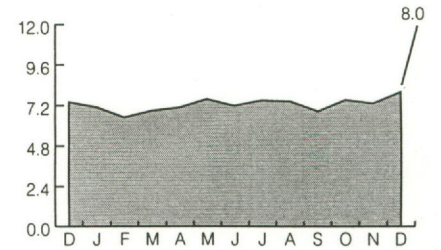

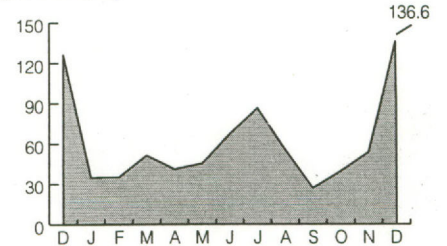

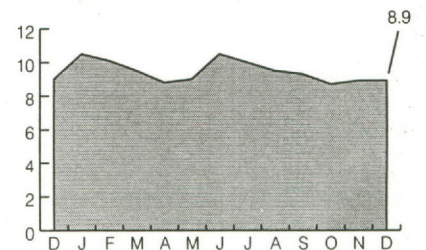

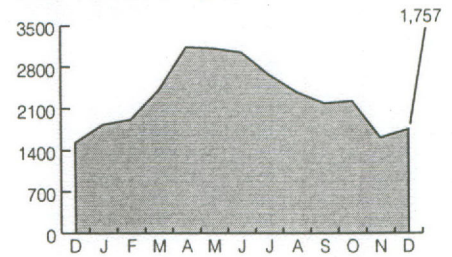
Percent of Unemployment All Cited Cities Combined

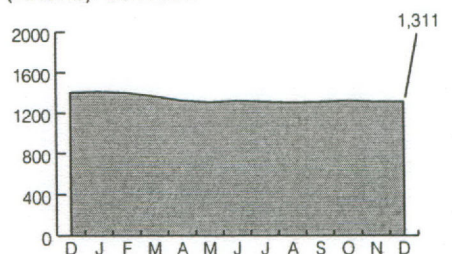

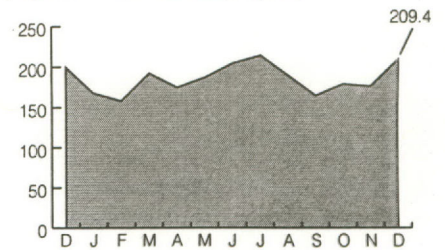

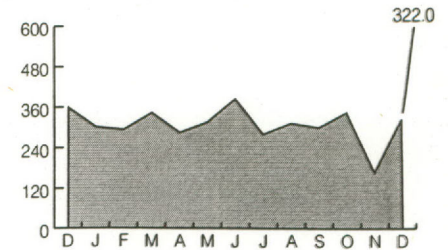

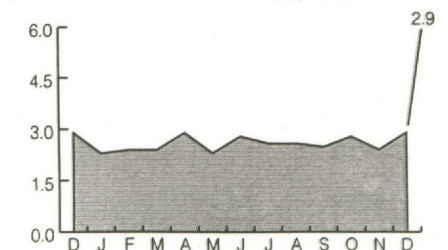
