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Border Business Indicators

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U.S.-Mexico Trade Up Slightly in the First Half of 2007

In the May 2007 issue of the *Border Business Indicators*, first quarter 2007 figures for U.S.-Mexico trade exhibited increases in U.S. imports from Mexico and total trade dollar value, and a slight decline in U.S. exports to Mexico over the same period in 2006. This trend changed in the second quarter of 2007 with modest single-digit increases in exports, imports and total trade values resulting in positive, yet reserved, percent changes for June 2007 year-to-date (See Table 1).

U.S. exports to Mexico, for June 2007 year-to-date, registered a small gain of 0.3 percent over the same period in 2006. U.S. imports from Mexico rose by 2.9 percent for the same time frame.

The U.S. was unable to reduce its trade deficit with Mexico. The deficit year-to-date was \$33.9 billion, an increase of 8.3 percent for the same period in the previous year.

Historically, the trade of goods between the U.S. and Mexico has been concentrated at their border ports. The percentage of the dollar value of goods processed at these ports has hovered around 80 percent. For the first half of 2007, it was 81.2 percent.

The border ports continue to be the hubs of trade activity between the partners. Table 2 exhibits the dollar value of the trade activity that took place on the border in the first half of this year.

Table 3 delineates the total dollar value of trade activity—U.S. exports plus U.S. imports—at the individual border ports of entry on the U.S.-Mexico border for the first half of 2007 in comparison with the same period in 2006.

On the back page, tables 4 and 5 provide the dollar value of U.S. exports to Mexico and U.S. imports from Mexico for the same period.

In upcoming issues of the *Border Business Indicators*, these trends in trade activity will be reviewed. In addition, the composition of trade or type of goods that comprise these dollar values will also be examined.

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
Note from the Director

Indicators of border business activity for June 2007 year-to-date (YTD) demonstrated twelve indicators increased and ten decreased. 2007 YTD comparisons to 2006 reported for the border are listed below:

- Pedestrian bridge crossings into Mexico were down 0.2 percent.
- Pedestrian bridge crossings into Texas were up 4.6 percent.
- Vehicle bridge crossings into Mexico fell 5.3 percent.
- Vehicle bridge crossings into Texas fell 6.2 percent.
- Truck bridge crossings into Mexico lost 2.2 percent.
- Truck bridge crossings into Texas gained 2.1 percent.
- Rail car bridge crossings into Mexico went up 1.4 percent.
- Rail car bridge crossings into Texas went up 2.0 percent.
- Revenues collected by U.S. Customs increased 7.8 percent.
- Revenues collected by U.S. bridge operators registered a loss of 1.6 percent.
- Tourist visas issued for entry into Mexico were down 6.3 percent.
- Total employment was up 1.1 percent, with 5,137 jobs gained. The average unemployment rate for the border in June 2007 was 6.3 percent.
- Total building permits issued rose 0.8 percent.
- Total building permit values increased 104.7 percent.
- Power connections in service for residential were up 2.8 percent, commercial were up 2.9 percent and industrial were down 2.6 percent.
- Air passenger arrivals were down 23.9 percent, and departures were down 26.6 percent.
- Total cargo for the Port of Brownsville decreased 0.7 percent.
- Inbound cargo for the Port of Corpus Christi went up 0.7 percent, and outbound cargo went up 14.6 percent.



Pedestrians into Mexico All Cited Cities Jun. 2006 vs. Jun. 2007: Up **8.6**% (In Millions)



Pedestrians into Texas All Cited Cities Jun. 2006 vs. Jun. 2007: Up 12.5%



Customs Revenues for the District of Laredo Jun. 2006 vs. Jun. 2007: Up **3.8%** (In Millions of U.S.\$)





Bridge Revenues All Cited Cities Jun. 2006 vs. Jun. 2007: Down **0.5**% (In Millions of U.S.\$)






