Kerrville, Texas, Dec 4. 1899.

Dear Grandfather

I haven't written because I am still staying at the St. Charles, and help them there. Papa, Mama and the children got home all right. Aunt Lena and Aunt Sophie of San Antonio were here Saturday and Sunday. Mr. Mason is going to start on a weeks [sic] hunting trip tomorrow with one of the boarders.

Uncle Otto and his party came back from their hunting trip yesterday and left on yesterday's train.

At school were examined in algebra, and out of 25 pupils, I made the highest grade, which was $98\ 1/2\ \%$. We grade on a basis of $100\ \%$ at school.

I close now giving my best regards to Uncle Charlies, little Karl and Aunt Tony and the rest.
