FOREWORD

On November 10, 1978, Public Law 95-629, Title II, authorized the establishment of the San Antonio Missions National Historical Park. The legislative mandate requires the preservation, restoration and interpretation of four Spanish Missions in San Antonio, notably, Concepción, San José, San Juan and Espada Missions. In meeting these responsibilities, the National Park Service has engaged in serious research of primary sources related to the San Antonio Missions. This research project for a comprehensive microfilm index on archival materials deposited at the Old Spanish Mission Historical Research Library is an important item in understanding these primary sources. When the microfilm reels in this contract are completed, a giant step will have been taken in our attempts to understand the archival materials deposited in our area.

The National Park Service wishes to thank the Old Spanish Missions Historical Research Library and Our Lady of the Lake University, San Antonio, Texas, for their help and cooperation. We hope that the continuing spirit of cooperation will remain so that over the years the National Park Service can effectively carry out its responsibilities to the San Antonio Missions National Historical Park for the benefit and enjoyment of all Americans.
