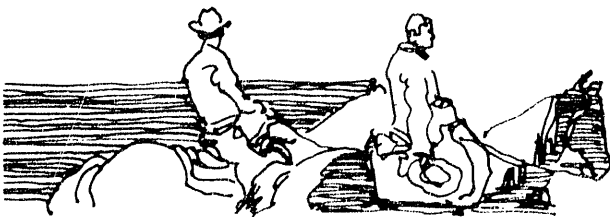

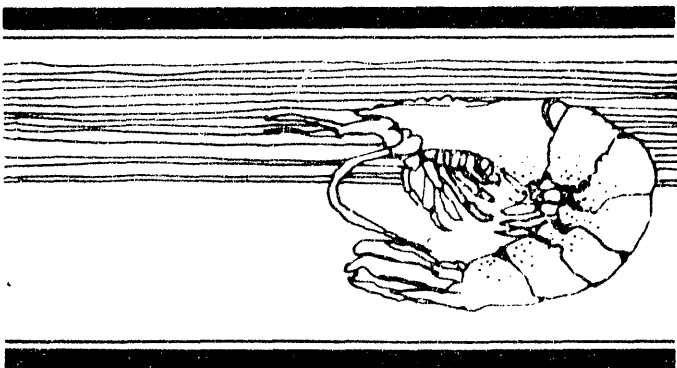

PROPOSED RULES

Numbering System-- Each rule is designated by a unique 10-digit number which is divided into four units by decimal points. The first unit (three digits) indicates the agency which promulgates the rule. The second unit (two digits) indicates the category of rules to which the rule belongs. The third unit (two digits) indicates the subcategory of rules, if any, within the category. The fourth unit (three digits) indicates the individual rule.

Symbology-- Changes to existing material are indicated in *bold italics*. [Brackets] indicate deletion of existing material.

State Board of Morticians Licensing and Enforcement Requirements-- General Rules of Practice and Procedure 387.01.00

The State Board of Morticians is proposing to adopt Rules 387.01.00.001-.007, which will govern the practice and procedures before the agency.

The licensing act was rewritten by the Texas Legislature in 1969 to obviate the need for procedural or substantive rulemaking. Consequently, the Board has not adopted any rules since the effective date of the 1969 amendments. Senate Bill 41 (The Administrative Procedure and Texas Register Act) passed in the 64th Legislature mandates the adoption of rules by all state agencies. It is the purpose of these proposed rules to satisfy that mandate.

Public comment on these proposed rules is invited. Persons should submit their comments in writing to James W. McCammon, Executive Secretary, State Board of Morticians, 1513 South Interstate 35, Austin, Texas 78741. Comments will be accepted until March 1, 1976.

These rules are proposed under the authority of Article 4582b, Texas Civil Statutes.

.001 Computation of Time. In computing any period of time prescribed or allowed by these rules, by order of the agency or by any applicable statute, the period shall begin on the day after the act, event, or default in controversy and conclude on the last day of such computed period, unless it be a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, in which event the period runs until the end of the next day which is neither a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday.

.002 Agreement To Be In Writing. No stipulation or agreement between the parties, their attorneys, or representatives with regard to any matter involved in any pro-

ceeding before the agency shall be enforced unless it shall have been reduced to writing and signed by the parties or their authorized representatives, or unless it shall have been dictated into the record by them during the course of a hearing, or incorporated in an order bearing their written approval. This rule does not limit a party's liability to waive, modify, or stipulate any right or privilege afforded by these rules, unless precluded by law.

.003 Personal Service, Registered or Certified Mail. Where personal notice by the agency is required, the agency shall give notice by personal service or by registered or certified mail to the last known place of address, either residential or employment, of the person entitled to receive such notice.

.004 Appearances. Any party may appear before the agency and be represented by an attorney at law. Any person may appear on his own behalf, or by a *bona fide* full-time employee. A corporation, partnership, or association may appear and be represented by any *bona fide* officer, partner, or full-time employee.

.005 Motions for Postponement, Continuance, Withdrawal, or Dismissals of Matters Before the Agency. Motions for postponement, continuance, withdrawal, or dismissal of matters before the agency that have been instituted by persons other than Board members or employees of the agency, shall be in writing and filed with the Executive Secretary not less than five (5) days prior to the designated date that the matter is to be heard. Failure to comply with the above will constitute prejudice to refile of the matter before the agency.

.006 Place and Nature of Hearings. All hearings conducted in any proceeding shall be open to the public. All hearings shall be held at the agency's offices in Austin, Texas, unless for good and sufficient cause the agency shall designate another place of hearings in the interest of the public.

.007 Reporters and Transcripts. When a party makes a written request that a proceeding before the agency be transcribed, the party shall furnish his own stenographic reporter and be obligated to pay the costs of the stenographic time and transcript.

Licensing and Enforcement Requirements--Specific Substantive Rules 387.02.00

The State Board of Morticians is proposing to adopt Rules 387.02.00.001-.014, which will give notice to licensees and applicants before the State Board of the agency's construction of provisions of the licensing act, Article 4582b, Texas Civil Statutes, as amended.

The licensing act was rewritten by the Texas Legislature in 1969 to obviate the need for procedural or substantive rule-making. Consequently, the Board has not adopted any rules since the effective date of the 1969 amendments. Senate Bill 41 (The Administrative Procedure and Texas Register Act) passed in the 64th Legislature mandates the adoption of rules by all state agencies. It is the purpose of these proposed rules to satisfy that mandate.

Public comment on these proposed rules is invited. Persons should submit their comments in writing to James W. McCammon, Executive Secretary, State Board of Morticians, 1513 South Interstate 35, Austin, Texas 78741. Comments will be accepted until March 1, 1976.

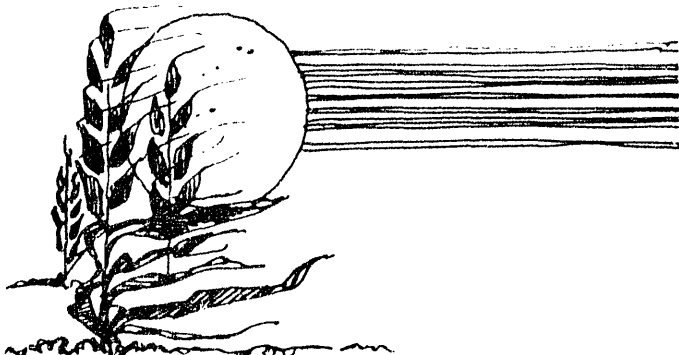
These rules are proposed under the authority of Article 4582b, Texas Civil Statutes.

.001 Definitions.

(a) The term "personal supervision" in Section 1-C of Article 4582b (Texas Civil Statutes) means that a licensed funeral director or embalmer must be present at the place and time of removal of the body.

(b) The term "licensed funeral establishment" in Section 1-F of Article 4582b, in addition to its ordinary meaning, also means commercial embalming establishment where apprentice is an applicant for only an embalming license.

(c) The term "licensed funeral director" in Section 1-G, Article 4582b, means the funeral director in charge. Such funeral director in charge must be reasonably and obviously in conduct of the business.



(d) Courses of instruction as specified in Section 1-J of Article 4582b shall include a course in practical funeral directing and embalming.

(e) The term "commercial embalmer" in Section 1-L of Article 4582b means the licensed funeral or embalming establishment.

.002 *Annual Report.* The annual report of the agency shall contain all the current rules and regulations of the agency.

.003 *Age of Applicants.* Anywhere the licensing Act, Article 4582b, refers to an age of twenty-one (21) years as a minimum age, the provision shall read eighteen (18) years of age.

.004 *Examination of Apprentices.* Apprentices must pass both oral and written examinations as given by the Board. Failure on one of the types of examination requires re-examination only on the failed portion. Re-examinations will be allowed and should be taken, where possible, at the next regular Board examination. A grade of seventy (70) must be made on each portion of the examination.

.005 *Time of Apprenticeship Periods.* Credit will be given for any twelve (12) month period during apprenticeship only if the period is served in twelve (12) consecutive months. An apprentice serving one (1) year of apprenticeship after passing the Board examination shall begin the apprenticeship within ninety (90) days after passing the examination.

.006 *Apprentice Case Reports; Responsibility.* Any case reports called for in Article 4582b are the responsibility of the apprentice. Penalties for failure to file these case reports will lie against the apprentice.

.007 *Apprenticeship Requirements and Standards; Substantial Compliance.* The Board may hear testimony or receive evidence as to why standards or requirements of apprenticeships cannot be met by an apprentice. Where, because of hardship or act of God, the applicant has been unable to meet such standards in spite of diligent effort, then the Board can make a finding of substantial compliance by such applicant.

.008 *Continuing Requirements of Apprenticeship.* An apprentice, throughout his apprenticeship period, must satisfy the definition of apprenticeship in Section 1-F of Article 4582b.

.009 *Requirements for Reciprocal Licenses.* An applicant for a reciprocal license, in addition to the requirements contained in Section 3-F(1), Article 4582b, must show to the Board that his license in the state from which he has removed himself was not lapsed at the time of removal. If license was lapsed, the applicant must satisfy the Board through examination as to his proficiency.

.010 *Advertising.* Nothing in these rules or in Article 4582b is construed by the Board to prohibit or restrict the

advertising of the availability of funeral services or the pricing of funeral services or merchandise.

.011 Licensing fees.

(a) The fee for licensing of a new establishment shall be \$250. Renewal of the establishment license shall be \$50.

(b) The fee for an apprenticeship application shall be \$10. Renewal of the apprenticeship license shall be \$10.

(c) The application fee for a funeral director and embalmer license shall be \$25 for each license. The annual renewal fee for each license shall be \$10.

(d) The fee for any duplicate license shall be \$7.50.

.012 Transfer of License Prohibited. No license provided for in Article 4582b is transferable, neither as to ownership nor location.

.013 Right of Inspection on Renewal. The Board shall have the right to inspect or investigate any circumstances involved with the renewal of any license provided for in Article 4582b.

.014 Display of Funeral Merchandise. The Board will approve only those display rooms in funeral establishments as meeting the requirements of Section 4-C6, Article 4582b, that are large enough to display a reasonable price range and model selection of merchandise, and that are designed and utilized to allow the public to make a private inspection and selection if they so desire.
