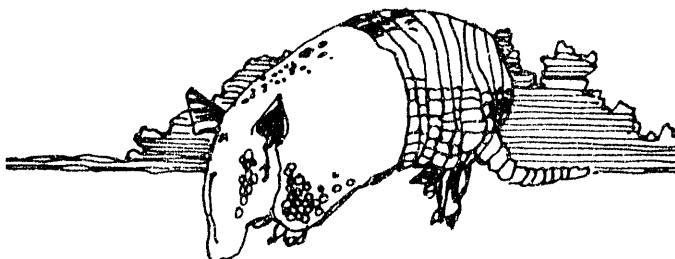

## Texas Board of Chiropractic Examiners

### Licenses and Renewals 380.02.00

The Texas Board of Chiropractic Examiners is proposing to adopt a rule to clearly specify its requirements for approving a refresher course for license renewal. These requirements are a minimum of eight hours of instruction on two consecutive days and must include four hours of instruction in philosophy, principles and practice, and radiography.

*.004. License Renewal Requirements.* A refresher course for license renewal to be approved by the Texas Board of Chiropractic Examiners shall consist of a minimum of two (2) full consecutive days of not less than eight (8) hours of instruction; and the qualifications of the instructors shall be equal to those teaching in recognized educational institutions.

The required subjects shall be philosophy or principles and practice, or radiography (for analytical and diagnostic purposes), or any other subject that is taught in chiropractic colleges recognized by the Board. Other subjects of professional interest may be included in the requirement when approved by this Board; provided, however, that half, or a minimum of four (4) hours, of the refresher course shall be devoted to philosophy, principles and practice, and radiography.

The method of checking attendance is the responsibility of the sponsoring organization.

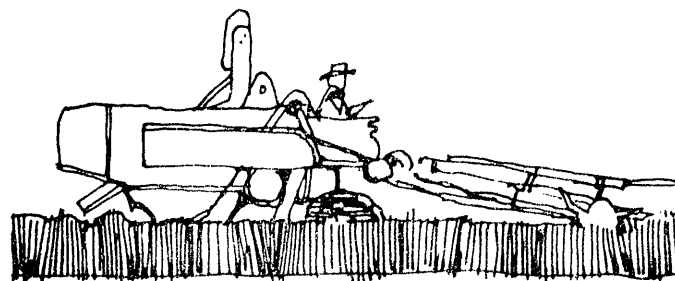
Licenseses residing other than in Texas are responsible for providing a copy of the program and certification of their attendance at that program to this Board if the refresher course they attended has not been previously certified for refresher work by the Texas Board of Chiropractic Examiners.

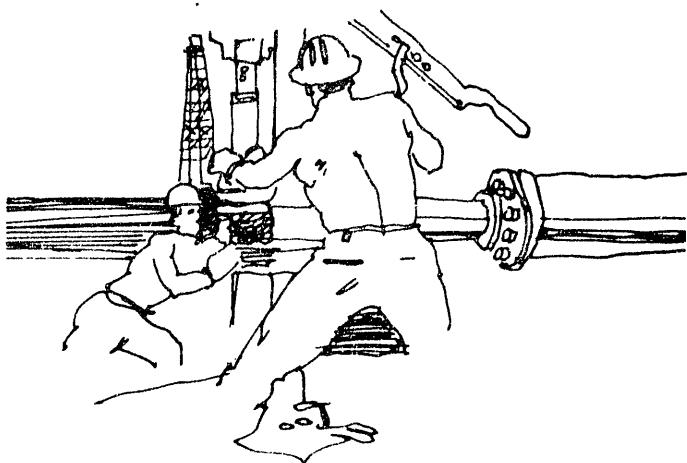

#### Tax 026.02.12

The Comptroller of Public Accounts is proposing to amend Rule 026.02.12.019 entitled Minimum Franchise Tax Payments by First Year Corporations.

Proposed amendment 1 would change the number of Section 1(b) of the rule to Section 1(c).

Proposed amendment 2 would add a new Section 1(b) to provide for the establishment of a due date for payment of the minimum franchise tax payment by certain first year corporations other than the due date that otherwise would be applicable under the Schedule of Minimum Tax Payments in the instance in which a corporation is assigned a filing date for its charter or certificate of authority which precedes the actual date on which the charter or certificate is approved and stamped "filed".

#### *.019. Minimum Franchise Tax Payments by First Year Corporations.*

*Section 1(b). When the charter of a domestic corporation, or the application for a certificate of authority of a foreign corporation, is approved and stamped "filed" by the Secretary of State, with a filing date assigned to the charter or certificate of authority that precedes the date of such approval and stamping, the Comptroller may establish, for all purposes under this ruling, a due date for such corporation's remittance of its minimum franchise tax payment other than the due date that may be shown for such corporation in the above schedule. The due date established by the Comptroller for such corporation will be typed or printed on the payment form mailed to the corporation in accordance with Section 2, below.*

(c). [(b).] Corporations excluded. Domestic corporations organized under the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act and foreign corporations issued a certificate of authority under such Act are not required to pay the minimum franchise tax payment prescribed in this ruling.
