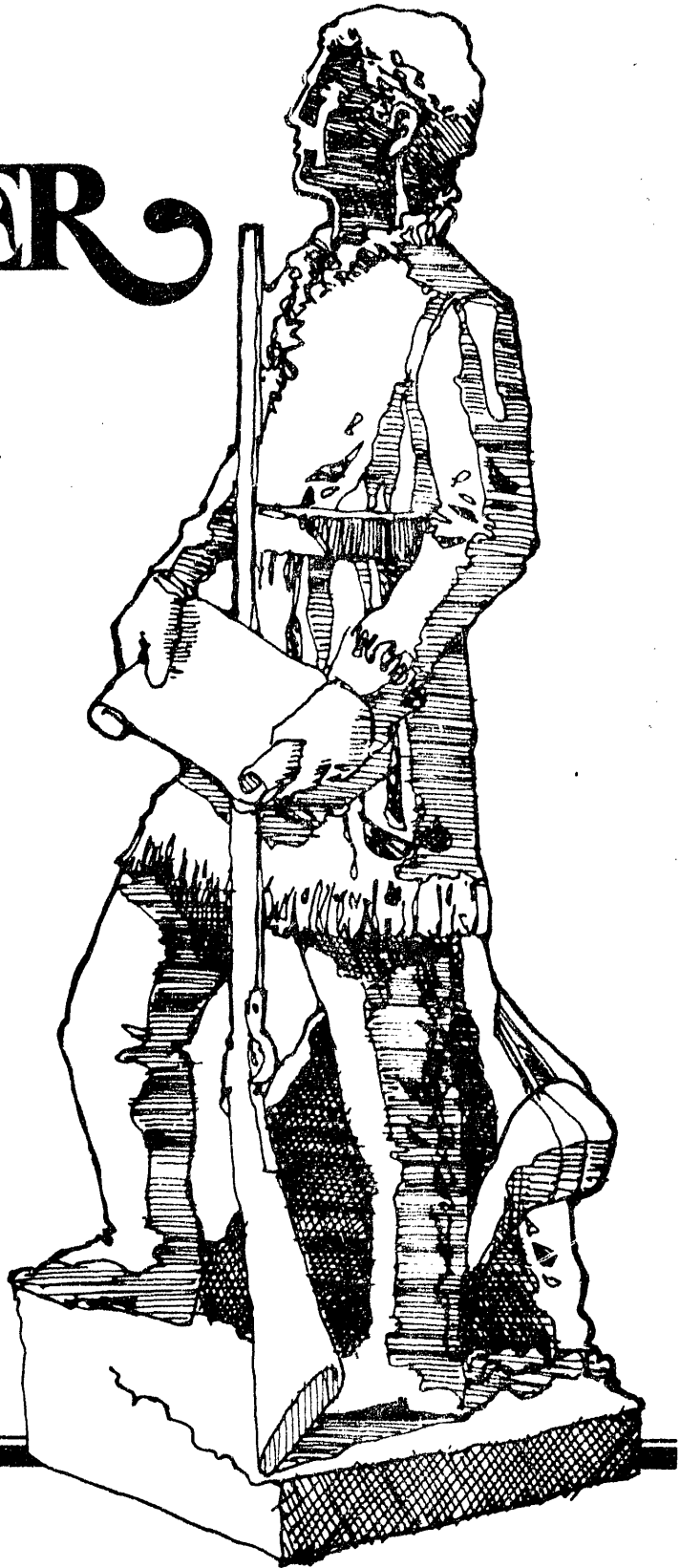

NOTES ON THE ISSUE

Secretary of State Mark White has requested that the Attorney General rule on the constitutionality of Article 14.03a of the Texas Election Code in light of a recent Supreme Court decision on that subject.

Another item of interest in the Attorney General's section is the opinion that the Federal Privacy Act, whose purpose is to provide safeguards for an individual against an invasion of privacy by requiring federal agencies to perform certain duties, has no application to the Texas National Guard while in state status, although it covers those employees of the National Guard who are classified as federal employees.

The Gas Utilities Division of the Railroad Commission of Texas entered an order in December, 1975, to phase out and eliminate natural gas as a boiler fuel in Texas. Requests for reconsideration of that order have been received and will be considered and decided upon at the March 3, 1976, meeting of the Gas Utilities Division. The notice of that meeting is published in this issue.
