This index has two principal types of entries: those *originated* by a governmental body (agency, office, and so forth), which are headed by a ***boldface italic type***, and those *about* a governmental body or other subject. If the agency entry is sufficiently descriptive and detailed, no subject entry appears. The arrangement is alphabetical, word by word, with a few exceptions.

State bodies are arranged by their first key words. Schools are arranged under their full name (Texas A&I University, Texas School for the Blind), unless the first word is university (Houston, University of). Quasi-state agencies are arranged under their full names (Deep East Texas Council of Governments.) State agencies which have had name changes are listed under their official names as of July 1, 1977, for this index. New agencies, resulting from mergers of other agencies, appear under their new titles after the change but under their original titles for references prior to the effective date of the change.

State bodies as subject entries are arranged first under the agencies' names. The rules submitted by that body follow with emergency rules first, followed by proposed rules, and then adopted rules. Within each group the rules are arranged numerically, as published in the *Register*. Meetings, hearings, and so forth are arranged chronologically according to the dates of the gatherings. Opinions, requests for opinions, and open records decisions from the attorney general are arranged numerically by the numbers assigned by that office.

Divisions of agencies are under the parent body unless the division has its own three-digit number. (Listings of the agencies and their numbers appear in Volume 1, Number 1, and in the first index, Volume 1, Number 33.) Thus the Governor's Energy Advisory Council is under Energy Advisory Council, Governor's, while the Governor's Committee on Traffic Safety is under Governor, Office of the, Committee on Traffic Safety.

The requests for opinions, opinions, open records decisions, and letters advisory of the attorney general and the administrative decisions of the comptroller include brief subject descriptions of their contents. Entries that refer to actions of the attorney general are designated by abbreviations: AG-- attorney general; RQ-- request for opinion; H-- opinion of Attorney General John Hill; ORD-- open records decision; LA-- letters advisory.

The laws of the state referenced in this index appear under the heading "laws of Texas" rather than under their titles.
