Ro: Authority of fost Texais state Toachers Colldge po furnish eorraspondence courses to cospres student:

Wo are in recelph of rour latter of ootober 80, 2040, requentine the opinion of thif Dopertrant, whioh reads as roliows:
"喵 have ppilation eor derreapondence work froma etudent in tho proirid Viow stato wormel. I moula like to have your opinjgn an to the legnilty of our handiling thi: application. I anderatand of course. that colored atudents are not peraittad to attend the atate institutione of highor Zearning for the wite, but $I$ do not know about correspondencemork. I chall thonk for your opinion in this conneethan."

There Have beon atablished in Texas frem time to tine Fexious intotitutions of higher learning, among wheh are a number of Stat Feaphert Colleges, Tormerly known as normal colleges. Such collegos bare been etablished for the training of both white and colornd teachert.

By Aetá 1879, page 201, the Legielature pretided for the establishment of Frairie View State Formal in the following language:
"Bec. 1. Se it enaoted by the Legislature of the State of Texay, That there ghall be estamlishod at Frairie View (formerly asiled Alta Vista). in Waller ecunty, in this state, nermal senool for the preparation and training of colored teanhers."

The name of such school wae aesigmated as "Prairie View state Normal and Industrial College" by lete 1899, page 385, and provimion ha been made for the maintenance, support and government of such sohool for the training of colored teachers and "for receiving suoh number of tudents of both sexes as the school can best accomodate." See articles 8638 to 2643, B. C. S. 1925.

The Wost Texas State Normal College was ostablished by the 3lst Legislature, fet 1909, page $85 \%$, which act raads in part as follows:
"Seotion 1. Thet a state Normal Sohool for the
education of white teachers is hereby establichod at a
place in rexae and located weat of the 98th maridian.
The nase of said normal school shall be the west Teras
State Normal College." (mpheais added)

By fots 1983, page 341, the name of the fieat Texas State Normal College was changed to "Weat Texas 3tate Teachera college."

The 2025 Revision of the Civil statuten of Texas does not carry forward and set out in fuld 411 the aots astabiishing the various Btate Teachors Colleges in Teras, but it 18 provided in articie 2644, K. C. s. 2020, as followis:
"zucept as herein provided, all lawe entabliohing 2tate Teachers Collegen or normal institutes for the training of white teachars providing for their government, control and maintanance are oontinued in force, and all sunt colleges which are or may be cetablished by law shall ba under the canersl control and managosaent of the Board of Regents of the state Teachere Colleges."

Artiole 2847, K. C. S. 2085, as anended, onumerates the powers and duties of the board of Regente of such colleges, and without referring in detail to the provisions thereof, we note that it is checrly contemplated that auch State reachers Colleges are for the education of white persone.

Prow a consideration of ta foregoing tets, and the various statutes applicable to the West Texas state Teachers College and Prairie View state Kormal and Industrial College, it becomes apperant that it was the legislative intent to prom vide the west Texas state Teachers Cellege for the education of white persons, and the Prairie Vime state Mormal \& Industrial College for the education of colored persons; each eparate and

independent and having separate sphere in which it might conduct its activities, the paoilitios of Prairie View state Normal and Industrial College being confined to the education of colored persons and wat Texas state Tenches Collage to white persons. The proper determination of your question. in our opinion, does not depend so much upon whether e student of one rads "attends" school for the other race, but whether pest Taxes State Toachora College hess statutory authorization to devote its funds and facilities to the oducstion of other than the white race.

It is our opinion that West texas State Teachers college is rot authorized to devote its funds and facilities to the education of colored students or teachers, either through attendance or by corresposienco courses, its powers having been limited by ito charter and applicable statutes.
