Opinion No. 0-4330

Re: It is not a violation of the enti-nepotism law where a first opusin of the County Judge is appointed assistant county attorney.

Tour request for an opinion has been received and carefully considered by this department. We quote from your request as follows:

"Please give an opinion on the following;

"Our County attorney desires to appoint an assistant County Attorney, and he has made application to the Commissioner's Sourt, in due order, a man that is the first Cousin to the County Judge of this County. Can the Commissioner's Court approve of this appointment without victating Art. \$32, %. C. and Art. 3902, R.C.S.?

"You will please be referred to Opinion-0-871, 0-1954 and 0-480.

Rince the Commissioners' Court merely authorizes the appointment of an essistant and does not name nor confirm the appointer it is our opinion, under the authorities cited in opinions Nos. C-480, C-875 and C-1954, copies of which are enclosed herewith for your information, that such appointment would not be illegal.
