the employer or his agent, a certificate signed by a legally licensed physician residing in the county where said person is to be employed, or is employed, attesting the fact that the bearer had been actually and thoroughly examined by such physician within a week prior to the time of such employment, and that such examination disclosed the fact that such person to be employed was free from any transmissible condition of any infectious or contagious disease; \* \* \*.

Thus, it is plain the statute does apply to public sleeping places, and your question, therefore, should be, and is answered "yes".

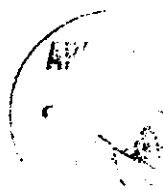
