

1 AN ACT  
2 relating to conditions of community supervision for persons  
3 convicted of certain criminal offenses involving animal cruelty.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 11, Article 42.12, Code of Criminal  
6 Procedure, is amended by adding Subsection (m) to read as follows:

7 (m) If a judge grants community supervision to a person  
8 convicted of an offense under Section 42.09, 42.091, 42.092, or  
9 42.10, Penal Code, the judge may require the person to attend a  
10 responsible pet owner course sponsored by a municipal animal  
11 shelter, as defined by Section 823.001, Health and Safety Code;  
12 that:

13 (1) receives federal, state, county, or municipal  
14 funds; and

15 (2) serves the county in which the court is located.

16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.




