

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the board of directors of the Greater East End
3 Management District.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Sections 3807.052(a) and (b), Special District
6 Local Laws Code, are amended to read as follows:

7 (a) The mayor and members of the governing body of the City
8 of Houston shall appoint directors from persons recommended by the
9 board. [~~Notwithstanding Subchapter D, Chapter 375, Local~~
10 ~~Government Code, to be qualified to serve as director, a person must~~
11 ~~be at least 18 years of age and:~~

12 [~~(1) be a resident of the district, or~~

13 [~~(2) have a district business interest.~~]

14 (b) Appointments to the board must ensure that [+

15 [(1)] at least one-third [~~60 percent~~] of the directors
16 are residents of the district[, and

17 [(2) ~~each director who does not reside in the district~~
18 ~~has a district business interest].~~

19 SECTION 2. Section 3807.052(c), Special District Local Laws
20 Code, is repealed.

21 SECTION 3. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
22 only to a person appointed to the board of directors of the Greater
23 East End Management District on or after the effective date of this
24 Act.

1 (b) The change in law made by this Act does not affect the
2 right of a person appointed to the board of directors of the Greater
3 East End Management District before the effective date of this Act
4 to continue to serve on the board until the person's term expires.

5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
9 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
