- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 22, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 22.011 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 22.011. REQUIRING OR COERCING EMPLOYEES TO MAKE
- 8 CHARITABLE CONTRIBUTIONS. (a) A school district board of trustees
- 9 or school district employee may not directly or indirectly require
- 10 or coerce any school district employee to:
- 11 (1) make a contribution to a charitable organization
- 12 or in response to a fund-raiser; or
- (2) attend a meeting called for the purpose of
- 14 soliciting charitable contributions.
- 15 (b) A school district board of trustees or school district
- 16 employee may not directly or indirectly require or coerce any
- 17 school district employee to refrain from:
- 18 (1) making a contribution to a charitable organization
- 19 or in response to a fund-raiser; or
- 20 (2) attending a meeting called for the purpose of
- 21 soliciting charitable contributions.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

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- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
