- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 441.168, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 441.168. MICROFILMING AND STORING LOCAL GOVERNMENT
- 8 RECORDS. (a) On request of a local government, the director and
- 9 librarian may provide for the microfilming or storage of the local
- 10 government records of that local government. Local government
- 11 records are open to the director and librarian for that purpose.
- 12 (b) The commission shall establish fees for the
- 13 microfilming and storage of local government records in amounts
- 14 sufficient to cover the costs of administering and expanding the
- 15 microfilming and storage services of the records management
- 16 division in the state library for the purpose of implementing
- 17 Subsection (a). The fees received under this section shall be
- 18 deposited in the state treasury in an account to be used only for
- 19 the costs of <u>administering</u> [administrating] and expanding
- 20 microfilming and storage services.
- 21 (c) The director and librarian may allow the state records
- 22 center to provide for the economical and efficient storage,
- 23 accessibility, protection, and final disposition of inactive and
- 24 vital local government records under this section.

- 1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
