- 8 county that imposes the tax under this chapter may audit the hotel
- 9 to determine the amount of taxes due under this chapter.
- 10 (b) After the county gives reasonable notice to the hotel
- 11 that the county intends to inspect the books or records of the
- 12 hotel, the county may access the hotel's books or records during
- 13 business hours as necessary to conduct the audit.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
