

1 AN ACT

2 relating to notice required upon nonrenewal of property and  
3 casualty insurance policies.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 551.105, Insurance Code, is amended to  
6 read as follows:

7 Sec. 551.105. NONRENEWAL OF POLICIES; NOTICE REQUIRED.

8 Unless the insurer has mailed written notice of nonrenewal to the  
9 insured not later than the 30th day before the date on which the  
10 insurance policy expires, an insurer must renew an insurance  
11 policy, at the request of the insured, on the expiration of the  
12 policy. Notwithstanding the failure of an insurer to comply with  
13 this section, the policy shall terminate on the effective date of  
14 any replacement or succeeding insurance policy with another carrier  
15 with respect to the insured (a) personal automobile, (b) home,  
16 farm, ranch, dwelling, duplex, or apartment, or (c) other real or  
17 personal property.

18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
