- 8 IN BEXAR COUNTY. Each full-time Bexar County criminal law
- 9 magistrate, with the consent and approval of the Commissioners
- 10 Court of Bexar County, may appoint an official court reporter to
- 11 serve that magistrate. The reporter is a sworn officer of the court
- 12 who holds office at the pleasure of the magistrate.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect October 1, 2011.
