- 5 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies to an
- 6 audit working paper created before, on, or after the effective date
- 7 of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
