Subchapter D, Chapter 71, Agriculture Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 71.154 to read as follows: 7 Sec. 71.154. DISCLAIMER REQUIRED. (a) A public entity, other than the department, that produces for public distribution to 8 9 commercial or residential landscapers a list of noxious or invasive 10 terrestrial plant species that includes a species growing in this 11 state shall provide with the list a disclaimer that states: "THIS 12 PLANT LIST IS ONLY A RECOMMENDATION AND HAS NO LEGAL EFFECT IN THE IT IS LAWFUL TO SELL, DISTRIBUTE, IMPORT, OR 13 STATE OF TEXAS. POSSESS A PLANT ON THIS LIST UNLESS THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF 14 15 AGRICULTURE LABELS THE PLANT AS NOXIOUS OR INVASIVE ON THE DEPARTMENT'S PLANT LIST." 16 17 (b) A public entity, other than the department, that 18 produces a list of noxious or invasive terrestrial plant species in printed material made for public distribution to commercial or 19 residential landscapers, including a newspaper, trade publication, 20 notice, circular, or Internet website, shall post the disclaimer 21 required by Subsection (a) in at least 12-point type in a 22 conspicuous location readily visible by persons viewing the list. 23 (c) The department shall adopt rules requiring a public 24

- 2 manner equivalent to the manner described by Subsection (b) for
- 3 publication of the entity's list of noxious or invasive terrestrial
- 4 plant species through media not described by Subsection (b),
- 5 including billboards, radio productions, and television
- 6 productions.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 71.154, Agriculture Code, as added by
- 8 this Act, applies only to a list that is published and distributed
- 9 on or after the effective date of this Act. A list that is published
- 10 or distributed before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 11 the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act,
- 12 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
