- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 28.0021, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (b) and (c) to read
- 8 as follows:
- 9 (a) The Texas essential knowledge and skills and Section
- 10 28.025 shall require instruction in personal financial literacy,
- 11 including instruction in methods of paying for college and other
- 12 postsecondary education and training, in one or more courses
- 13 required for high school graduation.
- 14 (b) Each school district and each open-enrollment charter
- 15 school that offers a high school program shall provide to a student
- 16 instruction in personal financial literacy in any course meeting
- 17 the requirements for an economics credit under Section 28.025,
- 18 using materials approved by the State Board of Education. The
- 19 <u>instruction</u> in personal financial literacy must include
- 20 <u>instruction on completing the application for federal student aid</u>
- 21 provided by the United States Department of Education. In
- 22 <u>fulfilling</u> the requirement to provide financial literacy
- 23 <u>instruction under</u> this section, a school district or
- 24 open-enrollment charter school may use an existing state, federal,

- 1 private, or nonprofit program that provides students without charge
- 2 the instruction described under this section. Each district and
- 3 <u>each open-enrollment</u> charter school that offers a high school
- 4 program shall ensure that a district or charter school student
- 5 enrolled at an institution of higher education in a dual credit
- 6 course meeting the requirements for an economics credit under
- 7 Section 28.025 receives the instruction described under this
- 8 subsection.
- 9 <u>(c)</u> The State Board of Education shall, not later than
- 10 January 31, 2012, identify the essential knowledge and skills of
- 11 personal financial literacy instruction to include instruction in
- 12 methods of paying for college and other postsecondary education and
- 13 training and shall, not later than August 31, 2012, approve under
- 14 Subsection (b) materials that provide for such instruction.
- 15 Beginning with the 2013-2014 school year, each school district and
- 16 <u>each open-enrollment</u> charter school that offers a high school
- 17 program shall include, in required instruction in personal
- 18 financial literacy, instruction in methods of paying for college
- 19 and other postsecondary education and training and use materials
- 20 approved for that purpose under Subsection (b) and shall ensure
- 21 that the instruction described under this subsection is provided to
- 22 <u>a district of charter school student enrolled at an institution of</u>
- 23 <u>higher education in a dual credit course meeting the requirements</u>
- 24 for an economics credit. This subsection expires September 1,
- 25 2014.
- SECTION 2. Section 28.0021(c), Education Code, as added by
- 27 this Act, applies to a student entering grade nine on or after the

- 1 effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
