

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the boater education program of the Parks and Wildlife
3 Department.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 31.108(f), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 (f) An agent acting under authority of Subsection (d):

8 (1) shall collect a \$10 examination or course fee and
9 forward the fee and any examination documentation to the department
10 not later than the 30th day after the date the examination or course
11 is administered; and

12 (2) may collect and keep a \$3 service fee, or an amount
13 set by the commission, whichever is greater.

14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
18 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
