9	SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS										
10	Sec. 8318.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:										
11	(1) "Board" means the district's board of directors.										
12	(2) "Commission" means the Texas Commission on										
13	Environmental Quality.										
14	(3) "Director" means a board member.										
15	(4) "District" means the Harris County Municipal										
16	Utility District No. 528.										
17	Sec. 8318.002. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a										
18	municipal utility district created under Section 59, Article XVI,										
19	Texas Constitution.										
20	Sec. 8318,003. CONFIRMATION AND DIRECTORS' ELECTION										
21	REQUIRED. The temporary directors shall hold an election to										
22	confirm the creation of the district and to elect five permanent										
23	directors as provided by Section 49.102, Water Code.										
24	Sec. 8318.004. CONSENT OF MUNICIPALITY REQUIRED. The										

temporary directors may not hold an election under Section 8318.003 1 until each municipality in whose corporate limits 2 or extraterritorial jurisdiction the district is located has 3 4 consented by ordinance or resolution to the creation of the district and to the inclusion of land in the district. 5 Sec. 8318.005. FINDINGS OF PUBLIC PURPOSE AND BENEFIT. (a) 6 7 The district is created to serve a public purpose and benefit. 8 (b) The district is created to accomplish the purposes of: 9 (1) a municipal utility district as provided by general law and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution; and 10 11 (2) Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, that 12 relate to the construction, acquisition, improvement, operation, or maintenance of macadamized, graveled, or payed roads, or 13 14 improvements, including storm drainage, in aid of those roads. Sec. 8318.006. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The 15 district is initially composed of the territory described by 16 17 Section 2 of the Act enacting this chapter. (b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of 18 19 the Act enacting this chapter form a closure. A mistake made in the field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process 20 does not affect the district's: 21 22 (1) organization, existence, or validity; 23 (2) right to issue any type of bond for the purposes 24 for which the district is created or to pay the principal of and interest on a bond; 25 26 (3) right to impose a tax; or

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(4) legality or operation.

3	Sec. 8318.051. GOVERNING BODY; TERMS. (a) The district is									
4	governed by a board of five elected directors.									
5	(b) Except as provided by Section 8318.052, directors serve									
6	staggered four-year terms.									
7	Sec. 8318.052. TEMPORARY DIRECTORS. (a) On or after									
8	September 1, 2011, the owner or owners of a majority of the assessed									
9	value of the real property in the district may submit a petition to									
10	the commission requesting that the commission appoint as temporary									
11	directors the five persons named in the petition. The commission									
12	shall appoint as temporary directors the five persons named in the									
13	<u>petition.</u>									
14	(b) Temporary directors serve until the earlier of:									
15	(1) the date permanent directors are elected under									
16	<u>Section 8318.003; or</u>									
17	(2) September 1, 2015.									
18	(c) If permanent directors have not been elected under									
19	Section 8318.003 and the terms of the temporary directors have									
20	expired, successor temporary directors shall be appointed or									
21	reappointed as provided by Subsection (d) to serve terms that									
22	expire on the earlier of:									
23	(1) the date permanent directors are elected under									
24	<u>Section 8318.003; or</u>									
25	(2) the fourth anniversary of the date of the									
26	appointment or reappointment.									
27	(d) If Subsection (c) applies, the owner or owners of a									

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majority of the assessed value of the real property in the district 1 2 may submit a petition to the commission requesting that the commission appoint as successor temporary directors the five 3 4 persons named in the petition. The commission shall appoint as successor temporary directors the five persons named in the 5 6 petition. 7 [Sections 8318.053-8318.100 reserved for expansion] 8 SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES 9 Sec. 8318.101. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties necessary to accomplish the purposes for 10 11 which the district is created. 12 Sec. 8318.102. MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT POWERS AND 13 DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties provided by the general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, 14 15 applicable to municipal utility districts created under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution. 16 Sec. 8318.103. AUTHORITY FOR ROAD PROJECTS. Under Section 17 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, the district may design, 18 acquire, construct, finance, issue bonds for, improve, operate, 19 maintain, and convey to this state, a county, or a municipality for 20 21 operation and maintenance macadamized, graveled, or paved roads, or 22 improvements, including storm drainage, in aid of those roads. 23 Sec. 8318.104. ROAD STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS. (a) A road 24 project must meet all applicable construction standards, zoning and

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25 <u>subdivision requirements, and regulations of each municipality in</u>
26 whose corporate limits or extraterritorial jurisdiction the road

27 project is located.

H.B. No. 886 1 (b) If a road project is not located in the corporate limits 2 or extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality, the road 3 project must meet all applicable construction standards, 4 subdivision requirements, and regulations of each county in which 5 the road project is located. 6 (c) If the state will maintain and operate the road, the 7 Texas Transportation Commission must approve the plans and 8 specifications of the road project. Sec. 8318.105. COMPLIANCE WITH MUNICIPAL CONSENT ORDINANCE 9 10 OR RESOLUTION. The district shall comply with all applicable 11 requirements of any ordinance or resolution adopted by the city 12 council of the City of Baytown. 13 Sec. 8318.106. LIMITATION ON USE OF EMINENT DOMAIN. The 14 district may not exercise the power of eminent domain outside the 15 district to acquire a site or easement for: 16 (1) a road project authorized by Section 8318.103; or 17 (2) a recreational facility as defined by Section 18 49.462, Water Code. 19 [Sections 8318.107-8318.150 reserved for expansion] 20 SUBCHAPTER D. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS 21 Sec. 8318.151. ELECTIONS REGARDING TAXES OR BONDS. (a) The 22 district may issue, without an election, bonds and other 23 obligations secured by: 24 (1) revenue other than ad valorem taxes; or 25 (2) contract payments described by Section 8318.153. 26 (b) The district must hold an election in the manner provided by Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, to obtain voter approval 27

Sec. 8318.152. OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE TAX. (a) If
 authorized at an election held under Section 8318.151, the district
 may impose an operation and maintenance tax on taxable property in
 the district in accordance with Section 49.107, Water Code.

11 (b) The board shall determine the tax rate. The rate may not
12 exceed the rate approved at the election.

Sec. 8318.153. CONTRACT TAXES. (a) In accordance with Section 49.108, Water Code, the district may impose a tax other than an operation and maintenance tax and use the revenue derived from the tax to make payments under a contract after the provisions of the contract have been approved by a majority of the district voters voting at an election held for that purpose.

(b) A contract approved by the district voters may contain a
 provision stating that the contract may be modified or amended by
 the board without further voter approval.

 SUBCHAPTER E. BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS
 Sec. 8318.201. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS AND OTHER
 OBLIGATIONS. The district may issue bonds or other obligations
 payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, impact fees,

27 revenue, contract payments, grants, or other district money, or any

1 combination of those sources, to pay for any authorized district
2 purpose.

3 Sec. 8318.202. TAXES FOR BONDS. At the time the district 4 issues bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, the 5 board shall provide for the annual imposition of a continuing 6 direct ad valorem tax, without limit as to rate or amount, while all 7 or part of the bonds are outstanding as required and in the manner 8 provided by Sections 54.601 and 54.602, Water Code.

9 <u>Sec. 8318.203. BONDS FOR ROAD PROJECTS. At the time of</u> 10 <u>issuance, the total principal amount of bonds or other obligations</u> 11 <u>issued or incurred to finance road projects and payable from ad</u> 12 <u>valorem taxes may not exceed one-fourth of the assessed value of the</u> 13 <u>real property in the district.</u>

SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,

officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
 Government Code.

4 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has 5 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on 6 Environmental Quality.

7 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed 8 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the 9 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of 10 representatives within the required time.

(d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled and accomplished.

15 SECTION 4. (a) Section 8318.106, Special District Local 16 Laws Code, as added by Section 1 of this Act, takes effect only if 17 this Act receives a two-thirds vote of all the members elected to 18 each house.

(b) If this Act does not receive a two-thirds vote of all the
members elected to each house, Subchapter C, Chapter 8318, Special
District Local Laws Code, as added by Section 1 of this Act, is
amended by adding Section 8318.106 to read as follows:

23 Sec. 8318.106. NO EMINENT DOMAIN POWER. The district may
 24 not exercise the power of eminent domain.

(c) This section is not intended to be an expression of a
legislative interpretation of the requirements of Section 17(c),
Article I, Texas Constitution.

SECTION 5. Except as provided by Section 4 of this Act, this
 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
